APPLICANT'S FOURTH RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 4

On January 7, 2014, Tri-County Special Utilities District, *Tri-County*, filed an application to amend a *Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* in Falls, Limestone, McLennan and Robertson Counties.

By prior orders, Applicant was given until January 20, 2015, to cure deficiencies. Due to miscommunication, Applicant believed that substantial progress had been made with the requests. On February 27, 2015, Applicant's representatives met in person with Commission staff in Austin to discuss the deficiencies and solutions.

In March of 2015, Applicant filed hard-copy maps with enough detail to locate the proposed water service. Applicant has contacted the City of Marlin's attorney to resolve the issue of *Exhibit A* that is missing from the agreement. Said exhibits are attached to the Response as Exhibit "A". The Public Utilities Commission staff and Applicant have worked together to cure deficiencies and ambiguities. Applicant's attorney did not learn of a mapping overlap problem until this week, and on May 12, 2014, Applicant's mapping service informed Applicant's attorney that they would no longer be working for Applicant. The attorney for Applicant has attempted to resolve this issue but is unable to submit electronic maps on the short notice and due to vacation of mapping personnel for PUC. Attached to this response as Exhibit "1" is Applicant's proposed resolution of the overlap

but would need until June 15, 2015 to submit the electronic maps and discuss with PUC representatives. The attorney for the PUC has no objection to extending the deadline to June 15, 2015.

Applicant requests an extension of time to supplement the application and will provide all required information by June 15, 2015, or provide the Commission with a detailed report on Applicant's progress in meeting the requirements.

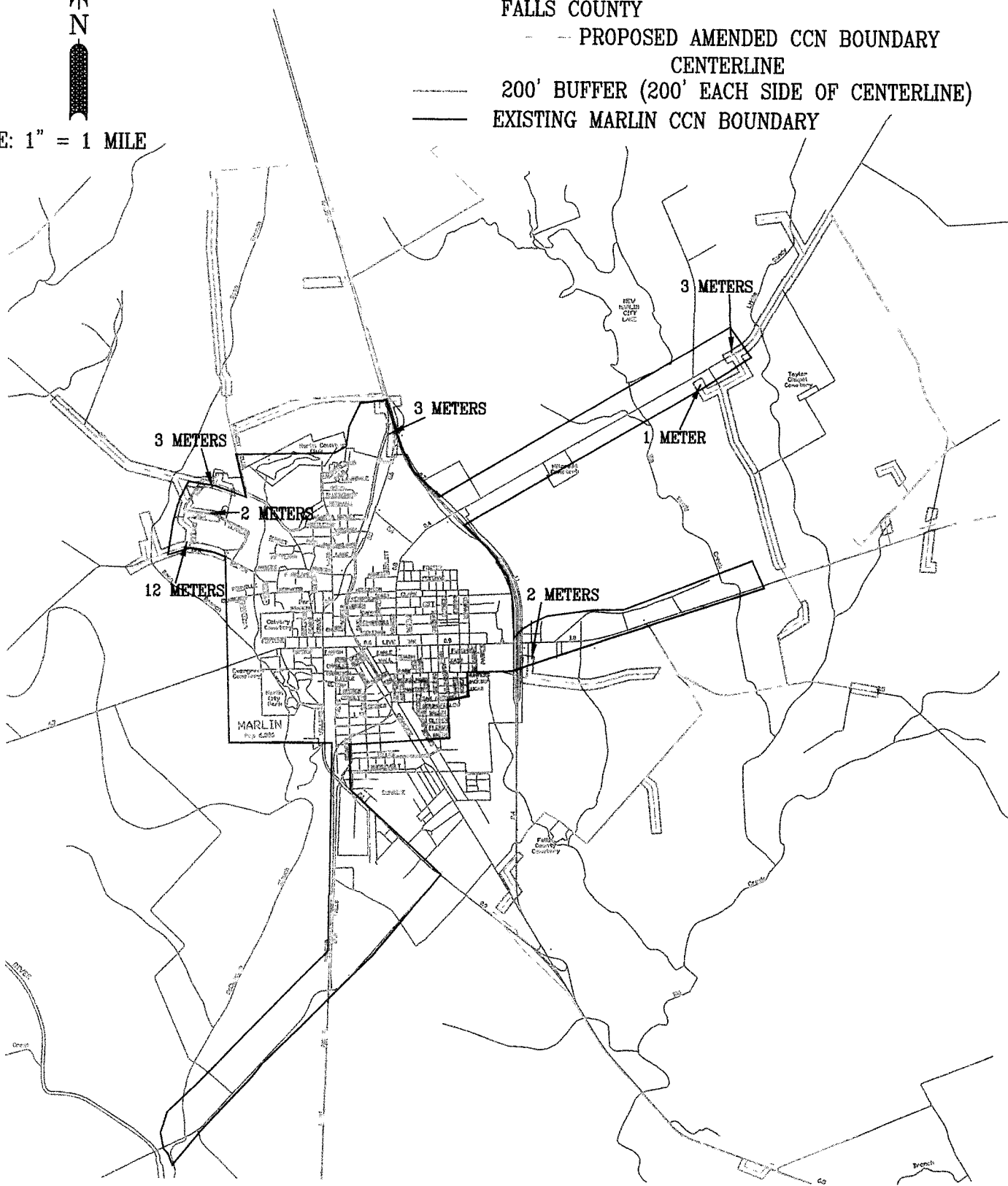

FALLS COUNTY

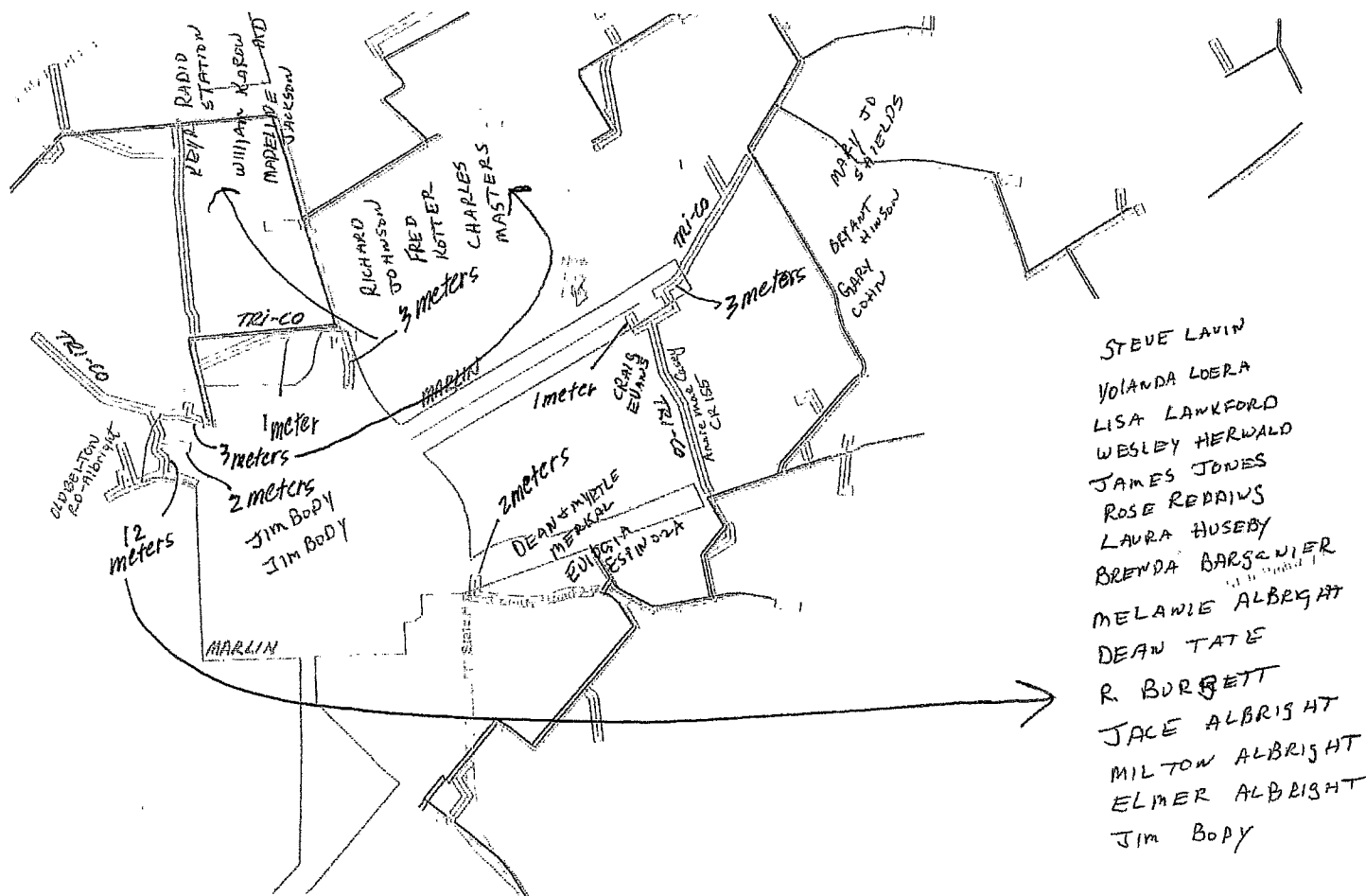
--- PROPOSED AMENDED CCN BOUNDARY
