**APPLICANT'S SIXTH RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 4**

On January 7, 2014, Tri-County Special Utilities District, *Tri-County*, filed an application to amend a *Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* in portions of Falls, Limestone, McLennan and Robertson Counties.

By prior orders, Applicant was given until July 30 2015, to cure deficiencies. Applicant continues to make progress to meet requirements, to work to provide maps that are sufficient to the Commission and continues to diligently communicate with Staff for the Commission.

In March of 2015, Applicant filed hard-copy maps with enough detail to locate the proposed water service. In the last two weeks, Staff and Applicant have spent time through conference calls and emails to cure deficiencies and ambiguities. Applicant has hired new engineering firm with mapping services and is working to replace the base maps of the proposed area to a base map with projection that is compatible with the projection used by Staff. However, the issue required representatives performing the mapping to transfer maps and to double check to insure that the maps reflect area intended by Applicant. Further, the applied for area covers portions of four counties, increasing the needed time. The representative's review of the maps since the last filing revealed many discrepancies between the maps submitted by the previous engineering firm and the actual

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location of the system lines. This discovery requires current mappers to carefully review hard copy maps, the system maps, and the data on file with the PUC. It is the goal of the current engineers to resolve all of the discrepancies to minimize issues with Staff's review and maximize accuracy. The attorney for the PUC has no objection to extending the deadline to September 30, 2015.

Applicant requests an extension of time to supplement the application and will provide properly revised maps by September 30, 2015, or provide the Commission with a detailed report on Applicant's progress in meeting the requirements.
