Dennis present a sample of how the a particular company handles it billing to customers. Concerns was expressed by Gracie that the customer would perhaps a true reading of the meter might not be submitted; therefore having the possibility of high past due accounts

Wanda - gave the example that one particular customer has high water bill and they had provide the customer with a new meter, but the reading continued to be high. Problem was that the toilet was broken. So if the customer read their own meter the possibility of high water usage could continue for months.

Munoz- the customers reading was tried in another town and it did not go over very well.

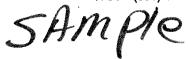

Wanda - Old bldg is completely detoriated and needs to be replace. The frame is okay. Dennis - he has some left over tin roof R-2 and he will donate the material for the roof. Ronald Hall will install the lights at no cost to the Tynan Water Supply Corp. (Tynan WSC).

C. Godwin Pumps Generator (Dennis)

Ronald - pump at the lift station should be okay. What is the price for a pump?

Melivin - about \$20,000.00

Melvin - The valley has one mobile station

Ronald - Ask TCEQ why we need a generator for each lift station

Melvin - Generator 3/4 phases, possibility of switching generators

Ronald - Lift stations setup in a rather unusual matter - Bumping up to make a lift station run

Gracie - what plants did you look at

Dennis - looked at the sewer plant only

Melvin - would take two to get a generator to Tynan in case of an emergency

Wanda - other town in the surrounding areas have generator rentals and it is acceptable to TCEQ

Melvin - provide a unit and move it around. Three Rivers has argued the matter with TCEQ

Dennis - need a contingency plan due to the time frame

Melvin - get generator, switch gears or purchase a generator & the generator needs to be tested once a year. Pump can be used at the lift stations - need to look at the sewer plant and lift stations

Dennis - I am the contact person and will work with Melvin Bode with Godwin Pumps

Ronald - Wiring must be correct - small pump

Melvin - go to a small 2 inch

Melvin - Texas Water Utilities has meeting scheduled in February 11, 2011

Dennis - no more questions - generator matter put on hold. Dennis- I will be the contact person for Tynan WSC for the generators

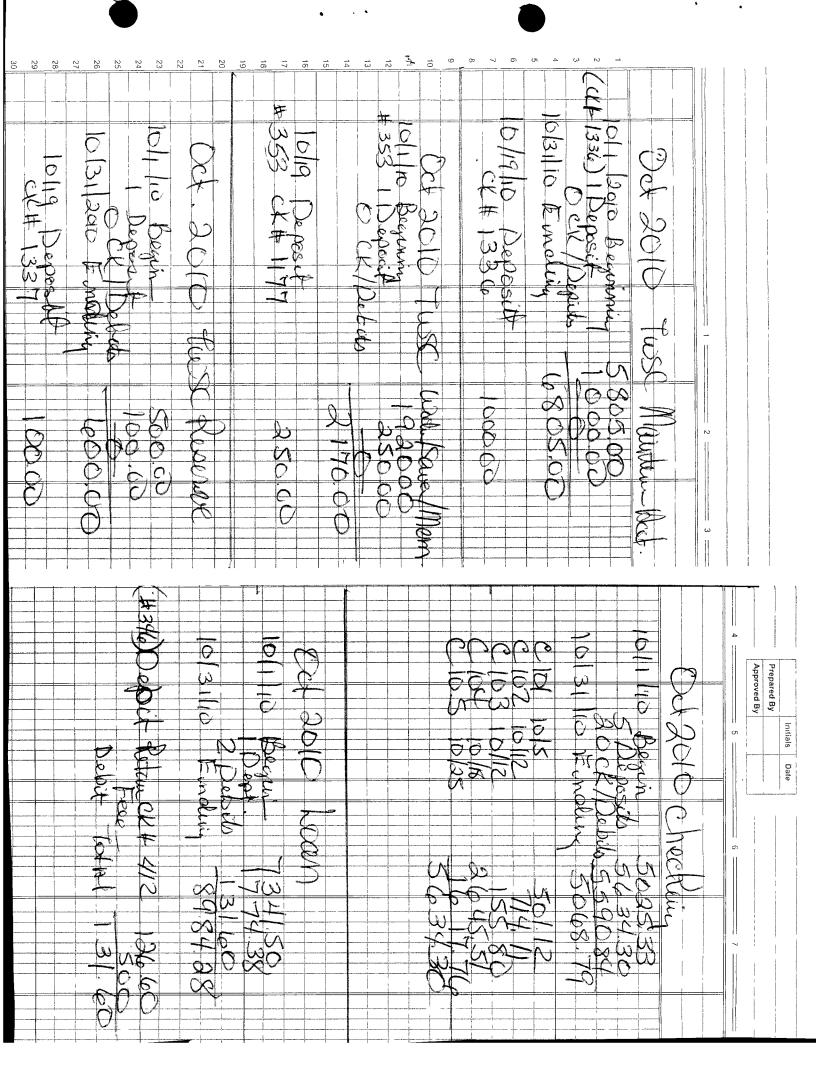

VI. Godwin Pumps - Sam Orta

A. Tabled - Godwin pumps has not contacted Mr. Perry.

Wanda - Small towns that can not afford to buy the generators have opted to rent generators to meet Texas Commission Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Small town only purchase generators when needed.

Gracie - we can do this until Grants monies are available, if Tynan WSC qualifies. Wanda - Contact Thomas Electric to wire the lift station. Wiring will be expensive. Lift Station 1 has some wiring ,however but the Sewer/Water & Lift stations are not wired for phase three, which is required by generators.

B. Naismith Engineering - Mr. Acuna Dennis is the lead person on this project. Measurement need to be performance on water/sewer lines that need repair, etc.

VII. New Business

A. TCEQ Discovery

Ofilia Jimenez and Brenda Loggins with TCEQ spoke September 20,2010 concerning the **First Fine** imposed on Tynan WSC. Discussion by Ofilia included that Tynan WSC could not pay the First Fine. Tynan WSC does not have the monies to pay the First or the Second Fine(s). Ms. Loggins advised she would speak to "**Management.**" At approximately 1:28 p.m. Mr. Loggins called and advised that she had discussed Tynan WSC situation with "**Management**" and **Management** had determined that the First Fine was deemed as "**Uncollectible Debit.**" Ms. Loggins stated that TCEQ would leave Tynan WSC alone. Tynan WSC should continue to do what you all are doing. Attached is a copy of the e-mail concerning this matter.

Received a letter from Margarita Salcedo, Enforcement Coordinator. Letter is the final phase concerning the Second Fine. Basically information in letter is to advise Tynan WSC if we have any problems or concerns on the Second Fine to contact her and that includes the generator(s) situation. Copy of letter and phone conversation comments are attached.

Meeting was cancelled, because Tynan WSC is prepare at this time to hold the meeting, due maintenance, and other various situations taking place at this time.

 plant are generated; there are a couple of connection that need to be replace due to
 corrosion.

Hello Ms. Jimenez,

Thank you for your email and for speaking with me earlier today.

As we discussed, the best program to help Tynan is the Community Development grant. That program's deadline was last Friday and I believe the County applied for a project in Pettus. The next deadline won't be until 2012 for the CD fund.

There is also the Colonia Fund, which will be due in early 2011. This program is geared to providing "first-time" water and sewer service (new connections to those on private septics or wells) and housing improvements, but part of the funds can be used to pay for non-first-time water/sewer items such as generators if the application is carefully structured. There are no other grant programs that I'm aware of that could help, only loan programs.

The Colonia grant would require a match of \$10,000 to \$20,000 from the WSC depending on how much the generators and related engineering are estimated to cost. The earliest funds would be available would be summer of 2011, but it could be later in the summer of 2012 depending on how well the application scores against the other counties.

Once the State (Texas Dept of Rural Affairs) releases the Colonia Fund application material in November, we will contact you and the County to start the process and plan the best strategy to create a high-scoring application that has a good chance to be funded.

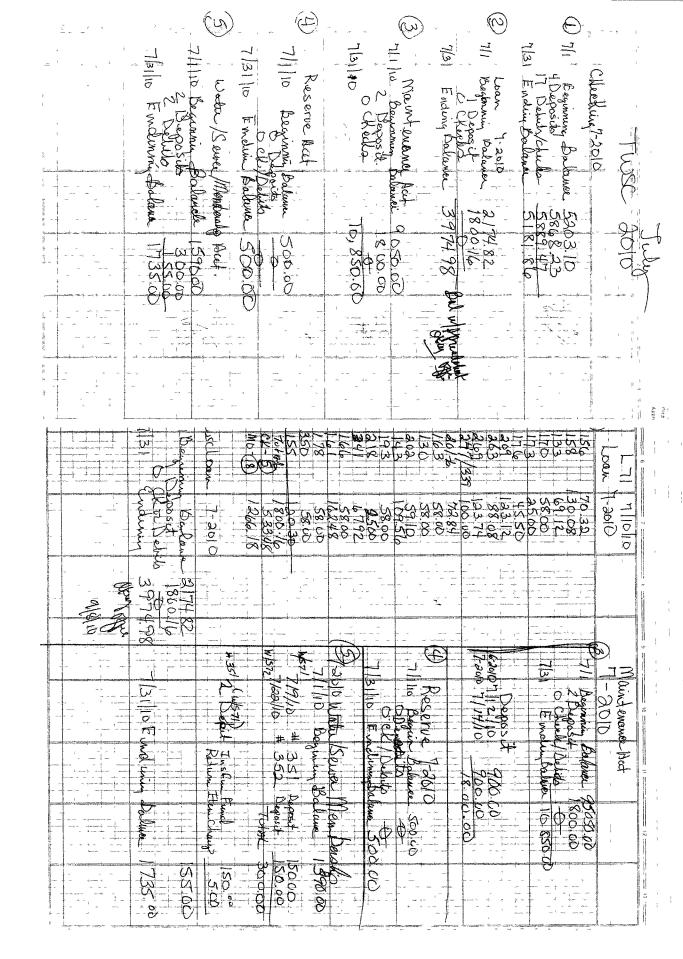
