ORDER NO. 6  
EXTENDING DEADLINES

On January 30, 2015, the City of Schertz filed a response to Order No. 4 requesting a second extension of time to cure specific application deficiencies, and including a plan to cure the remaining application deficiencies. Order No. 5 requested Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff to respond to Schertz's plan for curing deficiencies.

On February 10, 2015, Commission Staff responded that it is not opposed to the manner in which Schertz proposes to cure the application deficiencies. Specifically, Commission Staff agrees to the following terms:

- (1) Commission Staff accepts the Interlocal Agreement<sup>1</sup> that is attached to Schertz's January 30, 2015 filing, with a final, approved copy to be provided to the Commission by February 27, 2015, as a sufficient cure to deficiencies Nos. 1 and 2, provided the final approved copy contains all relevant signatures.
- (2) Commission Staff recommends granting Schertz an extension until March 3, 2015 to provide the Commission all relevant information that would cure deficiencies Nos. 3 and 4, as outlined in Staff's October 8, 2014, filing.

On or before **February 27, 2015**, Schertz shall file a final approved copy of the Interlocal Agreement. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Schertz is granted an extension until **March 3, 2015** to provide the necessary documentation to cure the remaining


deficiencies as outlined in Commission Staff's February 10, 2015 memo and the attached memorandum of Mary Lupo of the Commission's Water Division.

On or before **March 31, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.

Applicant shall not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.
