ORDER NO. 10 DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. Application

On August 29, 2014, the City of Schertz (Schertz), filed an application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 20271 in Bexar County, Texas. On October 9, 2014, Order No. 3 was issued, deeming the application deficient. On November 25, 2014, January 20, 2015 and March 31, 2015, Schertz provided supplemental information to cure certain deficiencies identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff.

II. Commission Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness

On May 1, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments on the sufficiency of the amended application. Commission Staff finds that Schertz's application, as amended, is sufficient for further review. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Schertz's application is deemed administratively complete and is accepted for filing.

III. Commission Staff Recommendation on Notice

Commission Staff has reviewed Schertz's proposed notice with regard to applicable statutes and rules, and recommends Schertz send the notice as described in Commission Staff's May 1, 2015 filing, and the attached memorandum of Mary Lupo, of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Specifically, Commission Staff recommended that Schertz be required to provide notice of the application using the form attached to the Commission Staff memorandum. Additionally, Commission Staff recommended that Schertz publish the approved

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notice once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Bexar County pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.106(c).

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Schertz shall provide notice as directed by Commission Staff. By the deadline set forth below, Schertz shall submit a copy of the actual notice sent with an attached signed affidavits that the notice was provided.
