COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Request for an Extension. Staff requests that the deadline for parties to file their joint proposed notice of approval be extended from March 27, 2015 to April 20, 2015. The applicant's representative is on vacation until April 6, 2015. In support of its Request for an Extension, Staff states the following:

I. Background

On May 7, 2014, Crystal Springs Water filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application to amend its CCN No. 11373 for a water system located in Montgomery County, Texas. Crystal Springs Water requested an amendment to its CCN No. 11373 in order to serve proposed residential development in Montgomery County, Texas.

On March 18, 2015, Staff filed its Recommendation on Final Disposition. Staff recommended that the Commission approve Crystal Springs Water's application and the requested amendment of Crystal Springs Water's CCN No. 11373. Additionally, recommended that the Commission find that Crystal Springs Water has the financial, managerial, and technical capability to provide continuous and adequate service to the proposed service area in Montgomery, Texas. As part of its Recommendation on Final Disposition, Staff attached a proposed amended CCN No. 11373, a map of the proposed service area in Montgomery County, Texas, and a tariff that is applicable to the proposed service area in Montgomery County, Texas.

Order No. 5 established March 27, 2015 as the deadline for Staff and Crystal Springs Water to file a proposed notice of approval.

Staff has discovered that Crystal Springs Water's authorized representative will be on vacation until April 6, 2015.

II. Request for an Extension

The Commission's procedural rules permit deadlines to be extended upon a showing of good cause.¹ There is good cause in this proceeding because Crystal Springs Water's authorized representative is currently unavailable to review and revise any proposed notice of approval. Thus, Staff requests that the deadline to file its supplemental recommendation be extended from March 27, 2015 to April 20, 2015. To the extent possible, the parties will attempt to file their proposed notice of approval earlier than the requested April 20, 2015 deadline.

III. Conclusion


Staff requests that the deadline for parties to file their joint proposed notice of approval be extended from March 27, 2015 to April 20, 2015.


