**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

I. Application

On May 7, 2014, Crystal Springs Water Co., Inc. (Crystal Springs) filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application to amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Montgomery County.

II. Staff Recommendation on Sufficiency of Application

On October 20, 2014, Commission Staff filed comments on the administrative completeness of the application. Staff has determined that the application contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's memo and the memorandum of Mary Lupo, Utility Rates Analyst/Auditor, Water Utilities Division. Commission Staff stated that the application is not administratively complete and should be deemed deficient.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given thirty (30) days to address the deficiencies noted in Commission Staff's memorandum. Commission Staff will file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

IV. Finding Application Deficient and Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Crystal Springs' application is found administratively incomplete. On or before **November 24, 2014**, Crystal Springs shall




amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding sufficiency of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule within ten working days of receipt of the amended application.
