ORDER NO. 8
APPROVING SALE/TRANSFER TO PROCEED

On May 9, 2014, Bear Springs Water Co., Inc. and Bear Springs Trails Water Supply Corporation, Inc. (Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificates of convenience and necessity in Bandera County.

On March 12, 2015, the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) issued Order No. 7, deeming the application administratively complete. On May 15, 2015, Commission Staff recommended that the sale/transfer as contemplated by the agreement of the parties may proceed and be consummated.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the sale/transfer as contemplated in the application shall proceed and be consummated. Within 30 days after the effective date of the transaction, the Applicants shall file proof that the sale/transfer has been consummated and customer deposits addressed. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.112(e) (TAC), the Applicants have 365 days to submit proof to the Commission that the transaction has been consummated. If closing documents are not submitted within this period, or an extension granted, approval of this transaction is void. The Applicants are advised that there will be no change to Bear Springs WSC's CCN until the transfer is complete in accordance with Commission rules.
