
ORDER NO. 5  
EXTENDING DEADLINES

On April 1, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a request for a good cause extension from April 6, 2015 to June 8, 2015 to file its recommendation on final disposition or to request a hearing on the merits in this proceeding. Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.102(a)(1), one criteria for granting or amending a certificate of convenience and necessity is water system approval by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). However, Commission Staff stated that Wiedenfeld Water Works, Incorporated (Wiedenfeld) is waiting on TCEQ approval of its water system. Commission Staff represents that Wiedenfeld does not oppose this request for an extension of time.

Commission Staff's request for an extension of time is granted. On or before **June 8, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file its recommendation on final disposition or request a hearing on the merits. Within two weeks following Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition, Wiedenfeld shall respond to Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition, request a hearing; or if no disputed issues exist, the parties shall file a proposed notice of approval, including fact statements, legal conclusions, and ordering paragraphs.
