**MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE**

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Motion to Admit Evidence. Staff requests that certain evidence be admitted into the record in support of its Proposed Notice of Approval. In support of its Motion to Admit Evidence, Staff states the following:

**I. Background**

On February 28, 2014, Wiedenfeld Water Works, Incorporated (Wiedenfeld Water) filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN No. 12052). Wiedenfeld Water requests an amendment to its water CCN No. 12052 in order to provide water service to the Monarch Hills Subdivision, which is located in Kerr County, Texas. The Monarch Hills Subdivision consists of sixteen (16) tracts and approximately 125 acres that adjoin the service area currently certificated under water CCN No. 12052. Wiedenfeld Water proposed to serve sixteen (16) additional connections.

Effective September 1, 2014, the Commission began the economic regulation of water and sewer utilities. Wiedenfeld Water's application, which was being processed at the TCEQ, was transferred to the Commission for processing.

On August 3 and 4, 2015, Staff filed its Recommendation on Final Disposition and Amended Recommendation on Final Disposition, respectively. Staff recommended that the Commission approve Wiedenfeld Water's application and the amendment of Wiedenfeld Water's water CCN No. 112052.

On August 20, 2015, Staff filed its Proposed Notice of Approval.
