COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Comment on Status, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 9, 2014, the City of Pleasanton (City) filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application for water and sewer Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Atascosa County. On October 24, 2014, Commission Staff filed comment stating that the application was administratively complete. On October 28, 2014, Order No. 3 was issued which found the application administratively incomplete and deficient. The City was required to amend its application on or before December 1, 2014, after which Staff was required to file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule within ten working days of receipt of the amended application. On December 1, 2014, the Commission received additional materials from the City.

II. REQUEST TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE


Staff respectfully requests to extend the deadline set in Order No. 3 to review the additional information provided by the City. Staff has limited resources available to review the additional information in the time provided. In order to afford Staff the opportunity to provide a thorough analysis of this application, Staff respectfully requests that the date for Staff's recommendation on whether the application is administratively complete be extended to **January 8, 2015**. At that time, Staff will file its comments on the administrative completeness and notice and provide a proposed procedural schedule.
