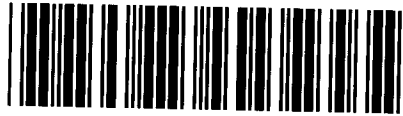

**COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 5 AND REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO REVIEW INFORMATION**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Response to Order No. 5 and Request for Extension of Time to Review Information, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 9, 2014, the City of Pleasanton (City) filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application for water and sewer Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Atascosa County. Order No. 5, issued on January 12, 2015, found the application administratively deficient and required that the City file additional information to address the deficiency by February 12, 2015 and that Staff file its supplemental recommendation by March 12, 2015.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO REVIEW INFORMATION

The City informally submitted the additional information to the Commission but the information was not officially filed with Central Records until March 11, 2015 and Staff was not able to start its review. Staff requests an extension of time until April 1, 2015 to review the additional information for administrative completeness.




