
**SOAH ORDER NO. 15
ADMITTING EVIDENCE, REMANDING CASE TO COMMISSION, AND
DISMISSING CASE FROM SOAH DOCKET**

On May 19, 2017, the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) filed a Joint Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand Proceeding (collectively, Motion), and a Joint Proposed Order. Staff and the City of Pleasanton (Pleasanton) have agreed on a Joint Proposed Order for Commission approval. The Administrative Law Judge grants the Motion. Accordingly, the following evidence is admitted.

1. Pleasanton's July 9, 2014 Application;
2. Proof of Notice filed August 21, 2015;
3. Additional Information Provided by Pleasanton on March 3, 2017; and
4. Staff's Final Recommendation filed on May 3, 2017.

Because this case has settled, it is remanded to the Commission for processing and is dismissed from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
