# COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 2 AND MOTION TO DISMISS DOCKET NO. 43366

COMES NOW, Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) and files this Staff's Response to Order No. 2 and Motion to Dismiss Docket No. 43366.

#### I. BACKGROUND

On March 17, 2014, The City of Primera (Applicant) filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application for a water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Cameron County, Texas. On June 5, 2014, the TCEQ sent the Applicant a notice of deficiency (NOD), directing the Applicant to provide additional mapping information and written descriptions of the proposed area. The TCEQ's NOD states that if this information is not provided by July 7, 2014, the application would be returned for failure to prosecute. On July 7, 2014, the Applicant sent the TCEQ revised mapping; however, it still did not meet the TCEQ's mapping requirements. On August 26, 2014, the TCEQ sent a letter notifying the Applicant that since its revised mapping did not cure the application's deficiencies, the application has been administratively closed.

#### II. AIS ITEM NO. 7

Staff has reviewed AIS Item No. 7 and has determined that it is not an amended application, but rather a portion of the Applicant's original application filed with the TCEQ on March 17, 2014.

#### III. MOTION TO DISMISS DOCKET NO. 43366

The TCEQ administratively closed Applicant's application, as evidenced by the letter dated August 26, 2014; a copy of this letter is attached. This matter transferred to the Public Utility Commission of Texas on September 1, 2014 and has been assigned docket number 43366. No motion to overturn was filed at the TCEQ before September 1 or at the Public Utility Commission thereafter. Consequently, Staff finds, the decision of the TCEQ is no longer subject to challenge. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests this docket be closed.

#### IV. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge enter an order in accordance with this filing.
