- B. A map showing **only** the proposed area by:
  - i. Metes and bounds survey certified by a licensed state or registered professional land surveyor; or
  - ii. Projectable digital data with metadata (proposed areas should be in a single record and clearly labeled). Also a data disk labeled with the applicant's name must be provided; or
  - iii. Following verifiable natural and man-made landmarks; or
  - iv. A copy of recorded plat map with metes and bounds; and
- C. A written description of the proposed service area;

- D. Provide separate and additional maps of the proposed area(s) to show the following:
- i. all facilities, illustrating separately facilities for production, transmission and distribution of the applicant's service(s); and
  - ii. any facilities, customers or area currently being served outside the applicant's certificated area(s).

Processing of the above referenced application cannot proceed and notices cannot be published or mailed until we receive the requested items. These items must be completed and returned to our office by **July 7, 2014**. If we do not receive the requested information by this date your application will be returned for failure to prosecute.
