- D. Provide separate and additional maps of the proposed area(s) to show the following:
 - i. all facilities, illustrating separately facilities for production, transmission and distribution of the applicant's service(s); and
 - ii. any facilities, customers or area currently being served outside the applicant's certificated area(s).

These items must be completed and returned to our office by **July 7, 2014**. If we do not receive the requested information by this date your application will be returned for failure to prosecute.
