ORDER NO. 6 FINDING DOCUMENTS INSUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING FILINGS

On March 27, 2015, Order No. 5 in the above-styled and numbered docket approved the sale/transfer to proceed.

On April 9, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff found that the documents submitted by HDU Services, LLC (HDU Services) on March 30, 2015, were missing a signature page and failed to address customer deposits. Commission Staff recommended that the documents submitted be found insufficient and that Curtis J. Shupak (Shupak) and HDU Services (collectively, Applicants) be afforded additional time to file sufficient documents.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the documents filed by Applicants are insufficient. Applicants shall file on or before May 26, 2015, a signed signature page by HDU Services and address the status of customer deposits. Further, within 10 working days of submission of the preceding documents, Commission Staff shall file a recommendation regarding sufficiency of the documents and propose a schedule for the continued processing of this docket.
