## ORDER NO. 5 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

On October 27, 2014 and on January 15, 2015, Order Nos. 3 and 4, respectively, deemed this application incomplete and deficient, therefore not administratively complete or ready for further review. On March 11 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff recommended that the application remains insufficient and administratively incomplete, as specifically described in Commission Staff's March 11, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo, Program Specialist, Water Utilities Division.

Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Commission Staff proposed that Wilderness Sound and HDU Services, LLC (collectively, Applicants) be given until March 27, 2015 to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before March 27, 2015, Applicants shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if necessary, on or before April 16, 2015.
