ORDER NO. 7
APPROVING SALE/TRANSFER TO PROCEED

On July 20, 2014, Wilderness Sound (Wilderness) and HDU Services, LLC (HDU) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and service area of Wilderness to HDU.

On June 11, 2015, Commission Staff recommended, following a review of the application, in combination with the supplemental filings, that Applicants be allowed to proceed with this transaction and that Applicants promptly provide the final sale documents so that final mapping can be contemplated.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the sale/transfer as contemplated in the application may proceed and be consummated. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than 30 days after the effective date of the transaction, Applicants shall file proof that the sale/transfer has been consummated and customer deposits addressed. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.112(e), the Applicants have 365 days to submit proof to the Commission that the transaction has been consummated. If closing documents are not submitted within this period, or an extension granted, approval of this transaction is void. The Applicants are advised that there will be no change to Applicants' certificates until the transfer is complete in accordance with Commission rules.


Beginning **July 13, 2015**, Applicants shall file monthly updates regarding the status of the transaction.

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Within 10 working days following the filing of Applicants' proof that the sale/transfer has been consummated and customer deposits (if any) have been addressed, Commission Staff shall file its recommendation on the adequacy of the documents.
