ORDER NO. 8  
FINDING DOCUMENTS SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING FILINGS


On July 15, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff found that the documents submitted by HDU Services, LLC (HDU Services) on July 3, 2015, provided sufficient proof that the sale in this proceeding has been consummated, and stated that the applicants have also provided sufficient proof that customer deposits have been properly transferred or refunded. Commission Staff stated that proposed maps and certificates and consent forms were distributed to the parties electronically on Monday, July 13, 2015. If the parties concur with the maps and certificates and submit signed consent forms on or before the deadline established below, Commission Staff will recommend that the application be approved and request that a final order be issued.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendations, sufficient proof has been provided that the sale in this docket has been consummated and customer deposits have been properly transferred or refunded. Further, the procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff, as modified, is adopted and shall apply to this proceeding:

Deadline for Wilderness Sound and HDU Services, LLC to sign and return the consent forms provided by Commission Staff, or to file a status update.	July 28, 2015
Deadline for Commission Staff's final recommendation, or proposed further procedural schedule or request for a hearing.	August 6, 2015
If no disputed issues, the parties will submit a proposed order including findings of fact, conclusions of law and ordering paragraphs	August 13, 2015
