COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 6

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas, representing the public interest, and files Commission Staff's Response to Order No. 6 and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 8, 2014, the City of Manor (Applicant) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10947 in Travis County, Texas. Manor states that a single developer has requested service from Manor for a project of approximately 773 connections.¹

In Order No. 6, issued February 10, 2015, Applicant was given until March 9, 2015 to provide proof of notice, and Staff was given a deadline of March 16, 2015 to review Manor's proof of notice and file an updated procedural schedule. Staff's Response to Order No. 6 is therefore timely filed.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEUDLE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule. Staff has consulted with Manor regarding the procedural schedule, and is authorized to represent that Manor does not oppose the following schedule:

Event	Date
Date Sufficient Application filed	February 10, 2015
Deadline for intervention; deadline for intervenors to file comments or request a hearing on the merits.	Monday, April 6, 2015. ²
Staff to propose an additional procedural schedule, request a hearing, or file a final recommendation.	Friday, June 5, 2015

Staff notes that customers have the ability to opt out of a CCN request. In the event customers wish to opt out of the CCN, additional procedures may be needed before Staff may make a recommendation. Therefore, Staff's proposed procedural schedule allows Staff the opportunity to either file a recommendation after the customer comment period or recommend an additional procedural schedule.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff recommends that Staff's proposed procedural schedule be adopted.

² Pursuant to 16 TAC 24.106(a)(3), the intervention deadline is 30 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. Notice was published on February 27 and March 6, 2015, and notice was mailed on March 6, 2015. Therefore, 30 days after March 6, 2015 is Sunday, April 5, 2015. The next working day is April 6, 2015.
