# ORDER NO. 2 GRANTING GOOD CAUSE EXCEPTION, FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES

#### Application I.

On July 8, 2014, the City of Manor, Texas filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application to amend water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 10947 in Travis County.

#### **Request for Good Cause Exception** II.

On October 2, 2014, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a motion for good cause exception to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8 requiring review of the application for administrative completeness within ten working days. Commission Staff requests to extend the deadline established in P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8 to October 2, 2014. The request is granted

### Staff Recommendation on Sufficiency of Application III.

On October 2, 2014, Commission Staff filed comments on the administrative completeness of the application. Staff has determined that the application contains material deficiencies, specifically regarding mapping information as described in the memorandum of Ahmad Tavakoly, Commission Staff, Water Utilities Division. Commission Staff stated that the application is not administratively complete and does not meet the requirements of TEX. WATER CODE § 13.244.

#### **Proposed Procedural Schedule** IV.

Commission Staff proposes that Manor be given thirty (30) days to address the deficiencies noted in Commission Staff's memorandum. Commission Staff will file additional

comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

## Finding Application Deficient and Opportunity to Cure V.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Manor's application is found On or before November 3, 2014, Manor shall amend its administratively incomplete. application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed and notice cannot be published or mailed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding sufficiency of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule within ten working days of receipt of the amended application.
