Dear Mr. Young:

On July 2, 2014, the Texas Commission of Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received planning material with your letter dated July 1, 2014 for the request for the proposed public water system. Based on our review the project generally meets the minimum requirements of the Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 290 - Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems (Rules) and is conditionally approved for construction if the project plans and specifications meet the following requirement(s):

- 1. On June 30, 2014, the Technical Review and Oversight Team (TROT) received an exception submittal for Sanitary Control Easement (SCE) for this project; please submit copies of the granting SCEs with the interim use submittal of wells.
- 2. Wellheads and pump bases shall be sealed by a gasket or sealing compound and properly vented to prevent the possibility of contaminating the well water as required by 30 TAC §290.41(c)(3)(K).
- 3. All community water systems shall comply with the requirements of 30 TAC §290.108 regarding radionuclide contaminants.
- 4. No area of the roof of a ground storage tank (GST) shall have a slope of less than 0.75 inch per foot as required by 30 TAC §290.41(c)(3).
- 5. All GSTs shall have a liquid level indicator located at the tank site as required by 30 TAC §290.41(c)(4).
- 6. All GSTs shall be thoroughly tight against leakage. All associated appurtenances including valves, pipes, and fittings shall be tight against leakage as required by 30 TAC §290.43(c)(6).
- 7. Pressure tank installations should be equipped with slow closing valves and time delay pump controls to eliminate water hammer and reduce the chance of tank failure as required by 30 TAC §290.43(d)(6).

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8. All associated appurtenances including valves, pipes and fittings connected to pressure tanks shall be thoroughly tight against leakage as required by 30 TAC §290.43(d)(7).

An appointed engineer must notify the TCEQ's Region 12 Office in Houston at (512) 767-3500 when construction will start.

Texas Water Code Section 36.0015 allows for the creation of groundwater conservation districts (GCD) as the preferred method of groundwater management. GCD's manage groundwater in many counties and are authorized to regulate production and spacing of water wells. Public water systems drilling wells within an existing GCD are responsible for meeting the GCD requirements. The authorization provided in this letter does not affect GCD authority to manage groundwater or issue permits.

The design engineer or water system representative is required to notify the Utilities Technical Review Team in writing by fax (512)239-6972 or email jose.castillo@tceq.texas.gov and cc: vera.poe@tceq.texas.gov at least 48 hours before the well casing pressure cementing begins. If pressure cementing is to begin on a Monday, then they must give notification on the preceding Thursday. If pressure cementing is to begin on Tuesday, then they must give notification on the preceding Friday.

The TCEQ does not approve this well for use as a public water supply at this time. We have enclosed a copy of the "Public Well Completion Data Checklist for Interim Approval." We provide this checklist to help you in obtaining interim approval to use this well before we can give final approval.

The submittal consisted of 15 sheets of engineering drawings, technical specifications and an engineering summary. This approval does not include any water distribution lines. The two wells are located in the same groundwater treatment site. A new application for a Certificate of Convenience & Necessity (CCN) for this project has been submitted to the Utilities Financial Review Team on August 21, 2014.

The proposed project consists of:

### The well items for Well-1

- Well No. 1 is a public water supply well drilled to 500 feet with 460 linear feet (lf) of 5-inch outside diameter (o.d.) Standard Dimension Ratios (SDR)-17 polyvinyl chloride (PVC) pipe casing and pressure-cemented 460 lf:
- 30 lf of 3-inch diameter stainless steel screen and 40 lf of 3-inch diameter steel blank liner overlapping the main casing;
- The Well No. 1 is rated for 65 gallons per minute (gpm) yield with a 7.5-horsepower (hp) motor size, submersible pump set at 315 feet deep. The design capacity of the pump is 65 gpm and a total dynamic head (TDH) of 280 feet;

# The well items for Well-2

• Well No. 2 is a public water supply well drilled to 500 feet with 460 lf of 5-inch o.d. SDR-17 PVC pipe casing and pressure-cemented 460 lf;

- 30 If of 3-inch diameter stainless steel screen and 40 If of 3-inch diameter steel blank liner overlapping the main casing;
- The Well No. 2 is rated for 65 gpm yield with a 7.5 hp motor size, submersible pump set at 315 feet deep. The design capacity of the pump is 65 gpm and a TDH of 280 feet;

### Additional items in project:

- One (1) 29'-81/2" diameter x 16'-1" height (83,000 gallons +/- working volume) bolted steel American Water Works Association (AWWA) Standard D103-09 GST;
- One (1) booster pump station with three (3) 170 gpm rate capacity (each) pumps and 150 feet of TDH;
- One (1) 2,957-gallon welded steel hydropneumatic tank;
- One (1) chlorinator building;
- One (1) hypochlorination equipment with two (2) positive displacement metering pumps and a minimum capacity of 8.0 gallons per day, (1) 75-gallon bleach storage tank made of high density polyethylene (HDPE) inside a 100 gallon HDPE containment tank;
- One (1) polyphosphate equipment with two (2) positive displacement metering pumps and a minimum capacity of 2.3 gallons per day, (1) 40-gallon polyphosphate storage tank made of HDPE inside a 55 gallon HDPE containment tank;
- One (1) 40 Kilowatts (Kw) gas engine generator;
- Various valves, fittings, related appurtenances and all necessary yard piping.

This approval is for the construction of the above listed items only. Any additional components contained in this design were not considered.

The August Lakes Water System public water system provides water treatment for the system.

This proposed project is located in the southwest corner of Clay and Pitts Road in Waller County Texas.

Please keep in mind that within 60 days of project completion the engineer must attest in writing that the project was constructed as described in the approved plans, specifications and any change orders filed with the TCEQ as required in Title 30 Texas Administrative Code §290.39(h)(3) of the Rules.

Please refer to the Utilities Technical Review Team's Log No. P-07022014-011 in all correspondence for this project. This will help complete our review and prevent it from being considered a new project.

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Please complete a copy of the most current Public Water System Plan Review Submittal form for any future submittals to TCEQ.
