**ORDER NO. 5  
ADDRESSING STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION FOR DISMISSAL;  
EXTENSION OF TIME**

On February 2, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a motion to dismiss the application of Quadvest, L.P. Commission Staff stated Quadvest failed to amend its application for an amendment as required by Order No. 3 issued on January 15, 2015. Commission Staff recommended the application be dismissed without prejudice.

On February 9, 2015, Commission Staff sent a letter to the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) and stated Quadvest had advised Commission Staff it had filed the information to cure the deficiencies in the application electronically with Central Records as required by Order No. 4 issued on February 4, 2015, and paper copies to be filed as well. Because the filing will not be entered into the docket until the paper copies are received, Commission Staff requests Quadvest be given until February 13, 2015, to complete the filing with Central Records. Commission Staff stated if the updated information is filed on or before Friday, February 13, 2015, it can review the updated filing and provide a recommendation within ten (10) working days. Commission Staff further stated if Quadvest fails to comply with the filing deadline it continues to recommend the application be dismissed without prejudice to refiling same.

Consistent with Commission Staff's request, Quadvest shall file its updated information on or before February 13, 2015. Upon receipt of the updated information, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on or before February 27, 2015.
