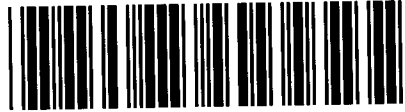

ORDER NO. 7
FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

I. Application

On December 16, 2015, Order No. 3 was issued, finding this application insufficient and incomplete. On March 12, the Town of Little Elm (Little Elm) provided supplemental information.

II. Proposed Procedural Schedule

On April 9, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed comments on the application, as supplemented. Commission Staff recommended that the application remains insufficient and incomplete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo, Program Specialist, in the Water Utilities Division.

Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given thirty (30) days to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is supplemented.

III. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Little Elm's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **May 11, 2015**, Little Elm shall file supplemental information to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule within ten working days of receipt of the amended application.
