
ORDER NO. 13
LIFTING ABATEMENT AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINE

On September 4, 2015, Order No. 12 continued the abatement in this proceeding and established a November 2, 2015 deadline for Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff and the Town of Little Elm (Little Elm) (collectively, the Parties) to file a request to unabate this proceeding or a status report. On November 2, 2015, Commission Staff filed a status update. Commission Staff stated that among other requests in this proceeding, Little Elm seeks to amend its sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20931. However, the nearby Town of Lakewood Village (Lakewood Village) is seeking to add the same service area to its sewer certificate.¹ Commission Staff stated that Little Elm and Lakewood Village have negotiated a resolution regarding city boundaries, and submitted additional mapping information on October 21, 2015. Commission Staff requested it be given until December 7, 2015 to review the additional mapping information submitted in order to provide a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness.

Consistent with Commission Staff's request, on or before **December 7, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of this application. The abatement in this proceeding is lifted.
