**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION**

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Supplemental Recommendation. Staff requests that the deadline to file a supplemental recommendation be extended from January 22, 2016 to February 8, 2016. In support of its Request for an Extension, Staff states the following:

**I. Background**

On April 24, 2014, the Town of Little Elm filed an application with the Texas Commission of Environmental Quality. Among the requests in the Town of Little Elm's application is an amendment to its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN No. 20931). The Town of Little Elm sought to add additional service area in Denton County, Texas. In Docket No. 43145, the Town of Lakewood Village is also seeking to add the same service area in Denton County, Texas.<sup>1</sup> Since the filing of their respective applications, the Town of Little Elm and the Town of Lakewood Village have reached an agreement regarding certain city boundaries.

On December 8, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge entered Order No. 14, which established January 7, 2016 as the deadline for the Town of Little Elm to file additional mapping information. Order No. 14 also required Staff to file a supplemental recommendation within ten (10) working days of receipt of this additional mapping information.

On January 7, 2016, the Town of Little Elm filed additional mapping information.

## **II. Request for an Extension**

The Commission's procedural rules permit deadlines to be extended upon a showing of good cause.<sup>2</sup> There is good cause in this proceeding because Staff needs additional time to review the additional mapping information submitted by the Town of Little Elm. Thus, Staff requests that the deadline to file its supplemental recommendation be extended from January 22, 2016 to February 8, 2016. Staff requests an extension to February 8, 2016 because that date is the deadline for Staff's supplemental recommendation regarding additional mapping information submitted by the Town of Lakewood Village in Docket No. 43145. To the extent possible, Staff will file its recommendation earlier than the requested February 8, 2016 deadline.

## **III. Conclusion**

Staff requests that the deadline to file a supplemental recommendation be extended from January 22, 2016 to February 8, 2016.
