ORDER NO. 17
FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

On December 8, 2015, Order No. 14 was issued, finding this application remained insufficient and incomplete. On January 7, 2016, the Town of Little Elm (Little Elm) provided supplemental mapping information. On February 22, 2016, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff recommended that the application, as supplemented, remains insufficient and incomplete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in the pleading and attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo and Tracy Harbour in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a) (TAC), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given thirty (30) days to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is supplemented.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Little Elm's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **March 21, 2016**, Little Elm shall file supplemental information to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule on or before **April 18, 2016**.
