
**ORDER NO. 24
REQUIRING CLARIFICATION**

This Order requires Commission Staff's to provide certain clarification. It appears that the decertifications requested in this application fall under Texas Water Code § 13.254 and 16 Texas administrative Code § 24.113. Therefore, either a certificate holder must provide written consent to a particular decertification or the Commission must make certain findings. In the Town of Little Elm's March 12, 2015 filing Mustang Special Utility District's consent to the requested partial decertification of its water and sewer certificates is provided. In addition there is discussion regarding Valencia on the Lake Water Control and Improvement District agreeing to allocate its water and sewer certificates in their entirety to Little Elm, effectively terminating Valencia's certificates. However, Valencia's consent to the decertifications requested in this application was not provided and Commission Staff's final recommendation does not indicate that Valencia's certificates will be terminated or cancelled. Second, it does not appear that the City of Oak Point provided written consent to the decertifications requested in this application.

On or before March 10, 2017, Commission Staff shall clarify the effect of the decertifications requested in this application on Valencia's water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity. Additionally, Commission Staff shall provide a copy of the written consent of Valencia and Oak Point to the decertifications requested in this application, if needed.
