
ORDER NO. 25
ESTABLISHING COMMISSION STAFF DEADLINE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's March 10, 2017 clarification and proposed procedural schedule. Commission Staff clarified that Valencia on the Lake Water Control and Improvement District's water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity would be completely cancelled by approval of this application, not partially decertified. Therefore, Commission Staff provided amended consents to Valencia that reflect complete cancellation rather than partial decertification. Valencia's signed amended consents were submitted by the Town of Little Elm on March 13, 2017.

Commission Staff proposed to file a supplemental final recommendation, motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval on April 11, 2017, two weeks after its proposed March 28, 2017 deadline for Valencia to file its signed amended consents. However, because Valencia's amended consents have already been filed, Commission Staff is given two weeks from the date of this Order. Accordingly, on or before March 29, 2017, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental final recommendation, supplemental motion to admit evidence and a supplemental notice of approval in this application, or propose additional deadlines as necessary.
