**TRAVIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 17'S  
RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 3**


COMES NOW the Travis County Water Control and Improvement District No. 17 (the "Applicant" or "District"), by and through its attorneys of record, and files this Response to the Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Administrative Law Judge's ("ALJ") Order No. 3.

Commission Staff filed its response to Order No. 2 on November 6, 2014. Staff reviewed the application filed by the District to amend its sewer certificate of convenience No. 20943 in Travis County, Texas and identified additional mapping information needed to complete Staff's review. Staff recommended the District be given 30 days to cure such deficiencies in its application. On November 7, 2014, the ALJ issued Order No. 3, extending the deadline for the District to respond to Commission Staff's additional mapping requirements on or before December 8, 2014. Thus, this Response is timely filed.

Attached hereto as Attachment A (Item D) is the list of sewer systems within a 2-mile radius of the proposed system. Attachment B-1 (Item A) is a revised general location map identifying the overall location of the District's Sewer CCN with enough detail to accurately locate the proposed area within the county. Attached hereto as Attachment B-6 (Item C) is a map of the proposed sewer service area showing the locations of sewer service requests within the proposed area. Attached hereto as Attachment B-7 (Item B) is a CD-Rom containing projectable digital data of the proposed area to be added, labeled with the projection used. These attachments address Items A, B, C, and D of Commission Staff's comments.



*TTWSSC has been the subject of numerous enforcement investigations and orders by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) over recent years, including violations of its current permit limits. The District is very concerned about maintaining water quality in the area of Lake Travis impacted by TTWSSC's discharge, especially given the close proximity of the discharge to the District's new raw water intake which provides public water supply (map enclosure, B-5).*

*In summary, it is in the community's and public interest to allow dual certification with the District in that it will (i) support the regionalization of sewer service in the area, (ii) meet customer requests for service from the District and (iii) decrease the dependence on the last remaining grandfathered effluent discharge into Lake Travis. It will also indirectly facilitate the service to neighboring property owners who now rely on septic systems to receive centralized wastewater service.*

### Item 2.D. – Explain why decertification of the area is in the public interest:

*The District is not seeking to decertify the area from the current certificate holder. However, the District is seeking dual certification of the area in response to paid service requests from area residents of the TTWSSC and for the additional reasons discussed in answer to Item 2.B. above.*
