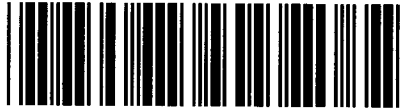

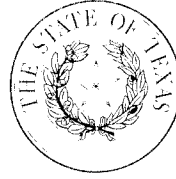

The Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality files the Executive Director's Response to Mustang Valley Water Supply Corporation's Motion to Remand.

RESPONSE MOTION TO APPLICANT'S MOTION TO REMAND

The Executive Director does not oppose Mustang Valley Water Supply Corporation's Motion to Remand. The Executive Director is not a party to the settlement agreement between the City of Meridian and Mustang Valley Water Supply Corporation. Further, the Executive Director is involved in a pending contested case matter, SOAH Docket No. 582-06-1367, TCEQ Docket No. 2005-2089-UCR, involving requested area sought by the City of Meridian and related to dually certificated area referenced in the parties settlement agreement. Thus, the Executive Director supports the single certificated area, not the dually certificated area, applied for by Mustang Valley Water Supply Corporation in the above referenced case, and supports the motion to remand those portions applied for by Mustang Valley Water Supply Corporation.




