EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S MOTION TO EXTEND PROCEDURAL DEADLINES

COMES NOW, the Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ" or "Commission"), by and through a representative of the Commission's Environmental Law Division, and files the Executive Director's Motion to Extend Procedural Deadlines. The Executive Director requests that procedural deadlines in SOAH Docket Nos. 582-04-0253 and 582-04-1268 be extended to match those in SOAH Docket No. 582-03-2730 so that this consolidated proceeding may be litigated concurrently in all dockets.

I. REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Earlier today, in Order No. 2 applicable to State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH") Docket No. 582-04-2730, the Honorable Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") extended the last day to propound written discovery on the parties until May 10, 2004 and revised several other deadlines. Currently, the Executive Director has entered into a Rule 11 agreement with City of Royse City ("Royse City"), allowing for an extended deadline for responses to the Executive Director's first round of discovery requests in exchange for an April 16, 2004 deadline for the last day for the Executive Director to propound written discovery requests to Royse City. The Executive Director has entered into a similar Rule 11 agreement with Honorable Dean M. Gandy for an April 19, 2004 deadline to propound written discovery requests. The Executive Director has also entered into similar Rule 11 agreements with City of Fate and Blackland WSC to grant the Executive Director a May 6, 2004 deadline to propound written discovery requests to those two entities. The Executive Director has not entered into a Rule 11 agreement with Verandah Communities, L.P., Verandah Freshwater Supply District, or Parker Creek Estates, L.P.

This morning's SOAH Order extends the deadline to serve discovery for all parties until May 10, 2004 in only SOAH Docket No. 582-03-2730 without extending the deadline for parties to serve discovery in SOAH Docket Nos. 582-04-0253 and 582-04-1268. However, the Executive Director believes it would be very difficult to confine any discovery requests that may be propounded on May 10, 2004 to only issues related to SOAH Docket No. 582-03-2730. The Executive Director submits that it would also be appropriate to extend the other deadlines outlined in today's ALJ Order. Therefore, the Executive Director respectfully requests that the

Honorable ALJ extend deadlines in SOAH Docket Nos. 582-04-0253 and 582-04-1268 to match those in SOAH Docket No. 582-03-2730.

II. CONCLUSION

The Executive Director respectfully requests that the ALJ extend deadlines in SOAH Docket Nos. 582-04-0253 and 582-04-1268 to match those in SOAH Docket No. 582-03-2730 so that this consolidated proceeding may be litigated concurrently. The Executive Director has conferred with representatives for all parties participating in SOAH Docket Nos. 582-04-0253 and 582-04-1268 except City of Fate (contact was attempted but unsuccessful), and those parties support the Executive Director's motion.

In the alternative, the Executive Director respectfully requests that the ALJ extend the deadline to propound written discovery requests in SOAH Docket Nos. 582-04-0253 and 582-04-1268 to correspond to the deadlines agreed upon by the Executive Director and certain parties in each Rule 11 Agreement described above.
