**ORDER NO. 4
 EXTENDING MEDIATION PERIOD AND
 AUTHORIZING RECALL OF MEDIATORS**

The mediation period in this case was earlier extended to December 15, 2005. Based on the ongoing efforts of the parties to resolve this matter, the mediation period is hereby further extended to **January 27, 2006**. On or before **December 15, 2005**, the parties shall update the status of their settlement discussion.

On November 15, 2005, the parties requested permission to re-contact the assigned mediators if necessary to advance settlement discussions. As the referral to mediation is still in effect, the parties, at their discretion, may contact them. The mediators may evaluate whether their further assistance would be necessary or appropriate and make recommendations on continuation of the mediation period. *The parties are reminded that judges assigned to mediations will usually have cases assigned to them well into the future, so their schedules as well as those of the parties would need to be accommodated in order to conduct a mediated settlement conference.*

The prehearing conference and hearing on the merits will remain scheduled for **February 16, 2006**, and **February 20-22, 2006**, respectively.
