

Written description of the proposed service area:

The area shall extend north along US Hwy 69 until it abuts the existing Duck Creek Water Supply Corporation CCN boundary. The proposed City of Lindale CCN will extend approximately 3280 feet northeast along the existing Duck Creek CCN boundary on a tributary of Mill Creek at which point it will go east approximately 340 feet and abut the existing Lindale Rural Water System CCN boundary at the confluence of Mill Creek. The proposed CCN boundary will then extend southeast and border the existing Lindale Rural Water CCN boundary to Hwy 16. South of the City of Lindale, the proposed CCN will extend southeast along the border of the existing Lindale Rural Water CCN, which is also CR 431 (Jim Hogg Road). The proposed CCN boundary will border Lindale Rural's CCN boundary west around Cooks Creek and CR 474 and then continue to follow and abut the existing boundary along Jim Hogg Road. This area shall extend southeast all the way to CR 461 at which point the proposed City of Lindale CCN boundary will travel west along CR 461. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WATER AND SEWER RATE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LINDALE, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES CONFLICTING

WHEREAS, it has become necessary and desirable to revise the rates for water and sewer service supplied by the City of Lindale to customers in order to both provide reasonable compensation to the City of Lindale therefore and to provide water and sewer service at reasonable rates to customers of the City of Lindale; and

WHEREAS, the rates hereinafter set out have, after investigations by the City Council of the City of Lindale, been found to be fair and reasonable,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINDALE, LINDALE, TEXAS:

I.

That the Water and Sewer Ordinance of the City of Lindale as amended December 18, 1995, be amended to read as follows:

AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF LINDALE AND LINDALE RURAL WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION REGARDING RETAIL WATER SERVICE

WHEREAS, the City of Lindale, Texas ("City") has either annexed the property more fully described in Exhibit "A" or the property is within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Lindale Rural Water Supply Corporation ("Rural Water") is a nonprofit water supply corporation;

WHEREAS, the property more fully described in Exhibit "A" is within the area that Rural Water has the right to render retail water service pursuant to its certificate of convenience and necessity;

WHEREAS, Rural Water owns personal property within the area more fully described as Exhibit "A";

WHEREAS, the City and Rural Water desire single certification of the area more fully described in Exhibit "A" for the City pursuant to Section 13.255 of the Texas Water Code;

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein, the City and Rural Water agree as follows:

- 1. Rural Water's certificate of convenience and necessity shall be modified to remove the property more fully described in Exhibit "A".
- 2. The property more fully described on Exhibit "A" shall be added to the City's certificate of convenience and necessity;
- 3. City shall provide retail water service to the property more fully described in Exhibit "A" pursuant to singe certification of the area as authorized by Section 13.255 of the Texas Water Code.

City of Lindale Application to Amend water/sewer CCN Existing Water Agreement

4. Rural Water hereby grants, sells and conveys to City all of its interest in the personal property located within the area more fully described in Exhibit "A".

5. City shall pay the sum of \$29,500.00 to Rural Water as consideration for the personal property transferred to City and the other covenants contained herein. Rural Water acknowledges that the compensation paid by City is just and adequate for the personal property, including the Rural Water's business in the area acquired by City.

6. The recitals to this Agreement are incorporated herein and shall be deemed representations and warranties by the parties.

7. This Agreement shall bind and benefit each of the parties and their legal successors and assigns. This agreement is solely for the benefit of the parties and their successors and assigns and is not intended to and shall not be construed to create any rights in favor of third parties.

8. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.

9. No alteration or amendment of this Agreement shall be effective unless given in writing and executed by all parties after approval by their respective governing body.

10. The parties hereby acknowledge that this Agreement was approved by their respective governing bodies at a joint meeting on Thursday, April 24, 1997 and the execution of this Agreement has been authorized by the governing bodies of the City and Rural Water.




