JOINT STATUS REPORT

Lindale Rural Water Supply Corporation and the City of Lindale (the "parties") submit this joint status report as requested by the Administrative Law Judge in Order No. 2.

Counsel and representatives from both Lindale Rural Water Supply Corporation and the City of Lindale have been working to resolve this matter amicably and without the need of either SOAH intervention or a formal mediation. The parties have come to an initial understanding but request additional time to complete settlement discussions. The parties estimate that they will require an additional 90 days, through December 15, 2005, to fully and finally settle this matter.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Lindale Rural Water Supply Corporation and the City of Lindale hereby request that SOAH allow the parties an additional 90 days, through December 15, 2005, to attempt to settle this matter. Should the parties not be able to resolve this dispute on their own, the parties request that they be able to contact the mediators and schedule a formal mediation at that time. The Parties will provide a supplemental Status Report by November 15, 2005. The parties further request any other relief to which they may be justly entitled in law or in equity.

JOINT STATUS REPORT

Lindale Rural Water Supply Corporation and the City of Lindale (the "parties") submit this joint status report as stipulated in the previous status report, dated September 15, 2005.

Counsel and representatives from both Lindale Rural Water Supply Corporation and the City of Lindale have been working to resolve this matter amicably and without the need of either SOAH intervention or a formal mediation. The parties have tentatively agreed to a service area map and are currently reviewing the terms and conditions of a proposed settlement agreement. To the extent there any remaining issues, the parties intend to meet on December 2, 2005 to work them out. The parties estimate that they will settle this matter prior to the December 15 date, earlier estimated.

PRAYER
