NEW WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION has filed an application for a CCN with the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission to provide water utility service in San Augustine, Sabine and Shelby Counties.

The proposed utility service area in San Augustine County is located approximately 6 miles South and 2 ½ miles west of downtown San Augustine, Texas and is generally bounded on the North by the Shelby, San Augustine line; on the East by Highway 96; on the South by Bobbitt Creek; and on the West by Attoyac Bayou. In Sabine County the system is generally bounded on the North by Patroon Creek; on the East by Colarow Creek; on the South by Highway 21; and on the West by Boggy Creek. In Shelby County the system is generally bounded on the North by Highway 87 & Highway 1279; on the East by Highway 87; on the South by the Sabine County line; and on the West by Highway 1279. The total area being requested will serve 438 customers.

The total area being requested includes approximately 108,000 acres and 0 current customers. See enclosed map of the proposed service area.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or other recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. No public hearing will be held unless a request for a hearing is received. Only those individuals who submit a written request to be notified of a hearing schedule will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
