We hereby transfer the official file for the above referenced application to the Chief Clerk's Office. Please refer this application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and request that a hearing be scheduled.

We received protests from Aqua Utilities, Inc dba Aqua Texas, Inc. and Aqua Development, Inc. (Aqua Texas), NAPD, Ltd., First Baptist Church, and the City of Woodcreek

Aqua Texas claimed that it has a justiciable interest as an "Affected Person" as defined by Texas Water Code Chapter 13 and the rules of the Commission. Also, the City of Woodcreek claims that a large percent of the proposed service area is in the ETJ of the City of Woodcreek. The First Baptist Church and NAPD, Ltd. indicated that they would be adversely affected since their properties is located within the proposed service area.

Pursuant to Section 13.246(h), Roger J. Engemoen, Jr., Trustee for Estelle Ervine Engemoen Trust, requested an exclusion of the 148.221 acres located within the proposed service area.
