No violations were documented during the investigation. However, several areas of concern were noted and should be addressed prior to potential future investigations. ## SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATION FINDINGS Blue Hole WWTP,

#1 Blue Hole Rd. Near CR 173 and CR 3237, Wimberley (Hays County), Texas
TNRCC ID No.: WQ0013321-001
Investigation Date: November 28, 2001

### Areas of Concern

1. WQ0013321-001, Section VI, Provision 8; 30 Tex. Admin. Code Section §319.5 - Required sampling location and frequency of analysis or measurement.

During the investigation, it was observed that annual soil samples were obtained on November 27, 2001 based on the chain of custody documentation provided during the investigation. These samples should have been obtained and reported prior to the end of September 2001. A response to the previous investigation indicated that the soil samples would be obtained as required. Soil samples were not obtained prior to the end of September. However, it was observed that the reporting forms provided by the TNRCC were not received until after September 2001.

It is Blue Hole Management's responsibility to ensure that samples are obtained and reported in accordance with the permitted requirements.

2. WQ0013321-001, Section VI, Provision 21; 30 Tex. Admin. Code Section §305.125(1) - Standard Permit Conditions. The permittee has a duty to comply with all permit conditions. Failure to comply with any permit condition is a violation of the permit and statutes under which it was issued and is grounds for enforcement action, for permit amendment, revocation or suspension, or for denial of a permit renewal application or an application for a permit for another facility.

During the investigation, no backup generator was present as required per Section VI, Provision 21 of the permit. This issue was discussed during the previous investigation and Blue Hole Management's response was that the system is on a dual grid power supply and that a back up generator is not necessary. Since that time, Blue Hole has received a renewal on the permit, but the requirement is still in the permit for the back up generator.

In order to address this concern, Blue Hole Management must have the permit requirement removed, or documentation in writing from the TNRCC Wastewater Permitting Section that indicates the system in place demonstrates compliance with the permit provision.

3. WQ0013321-001, Section IV, Condition B, 30 Tex. Admin. Code §319.5 - Required sampling location and frequency of analysis or measurement.

Due to weather conditions, a sample for BOD was not collected during the investigation. Additionally, the November analytical results were not available. Chain of custody documentation indicates a sample was obtained on 11/27/01. Since that time, a sample was collected on December 7, 2001, but results received on December 21, 2001 yielded inconclusive results.

As noted during the previous investigation's, there have been violations of the sampling requirement and exceedance of the effluent limitation for BOD. Future violations in these area's may result in more formal enforcement action. Blue Hole Management must collect samples monthly as required. Additionally, any excursion of the BOD limitation should be reported to this office.

- H. OTHER COMMENTS: (X) Applicable () N/A As found in the file review, a previous investigation was conducted on June 12, 2001. Prior to that event, an investigation was conducted on April 11, 2000. The current permit was issued on June 13, 2001 and is valid through February 1, 2005. During the previous investigation, violations were alleged for an exceedance on a permitted limitation, failure to obtain samples on a monthly basis, failure to sample sludge and analyze for TCLP, PCBs, metals, and fecal coliform, inoperable flow meter, and failure to obtain annual soil samples from the low pressure dosing field (LPD). A response was received by this office on August 14, 2001 and compliance letter was sent. Mr. Jon Clayton was present during the investigation. Mr. Clayton is a level "D" certified wastewater treatment plant operator. I provided him a copy of the customer service survey and the pamphlet entitled "The TNRCC Has Inspected Your Business...".

We began the investigation with a record review of the plant monitoring and reporting requirements including the special and standard provisions of Permit No. WQ0013321-001. Mr. Clayton had a current permit available during the investigation. We also reviewed issues relating to the previous CCI and response to the alleged violations received on August 14, 2001.

In response to the previous alleged violations, Mr. Clayton had indicated that a replacement flow meter had been installed, so and sludge samples had been obtained and that a backup generator was not necessary at the lift station since it was on a dual supply power grid. We discussed the response to the issues found during the previous CCI and the information obtained during this CCI. First, Mr. Clayton had flow meter records and pH readings available in his daily operating log. Based on the available records reviewed, flow and pH are being monitored in accordance with permitted requirements. The next item reviewed was sludge records. Sludge has been hauled by Keith Weidner, TNRCC Registration number 20801. Trip tickets were available and indicated that some sludge has been land applied at a registered beneficial land use (BLU) site. Testing had not been done as indicated in Mr. Clayton's response, however, the new permit became effective on June 13, 2001. Based on the effective date of the renewed permit, and the response date to the NOV, corrective action to date has been adequate. A sample for toxicity characteristics leaching procedure (TCLP) and for poly chlorinated biphenyl's (PCBs) had been collected on 11/27/01. Blue Hole has until 6/13/01 to collect their sample for fecal coliform and metal constituents. Soil samples from the irrigation area were also collected on 11/27/01. A copy of the chain of custody document was available. Analytical results were not available at the time of the investigation. Mr. Clayton was informed that he should contact the Enforcement Division concerning the reporting forms for the previous fiscal year. The forms he had were received after 9/01 for the 2001 reporting period. I informed him that this was an area of concern since he had indicated that soil samples had been submitted. On 12/3/01, Mr. Clayton contacted me and indicated he had discussed this issue with Ms. Meri Matl in the Enforcement Division and would be sending her a copy of the analytical report for the soil samples collected on 11/27/01. The last issue discussed was that a requirement that an emergency generator be available for the lift station. No emergency generator is available. However, the lift station is reportedly on a dual power grid. I indicated that the new permit has the requirement for an emergency generator and that this was an issue of concern We concluded with a review of his monthly analytical records for BOD analysis. He is sampling for BOD monthly as required

Based on the record review, Blue Hole did not collect soil samples prior to 9/1/01 for the low pressure dosing fields. Also, a requirement remains in the permit for an emergency generator to be provided at the lift station. An emergency generator is not provided, but the lift station is reportedly on a dual power feed from the electric company. Lastly, one BOD sample was reported as 110 mg/l, slightly over the 100 mg/l requirement. Since the slight BOD excursion in August, the BOD samples have been within required parameters.

We concluded the investigation for that day. An on-site inspection of the plant could not be conducted. Significant rainfall the day before and during the investigation made the access to the plant a problem without a proper vehicle. Mr. Clayton indicated access was possible, but preferred that the road not be damaged. We agreed that a follow-up visit would be conducted. We scheduled a follow-up visit for 12/5/01, but due to a Clayton family emergency, a site visit was not conducted. On 12/7/01, I contacted Mr. Clayton and requested he obtain a sample for BOD. Mr. Clayton indicated he would obtain the sample. On 12/21/01, I contacted Mr. Clayton. He was not available, but his wife indicated the sample was collected and she would contact the laboratory and have a copy of the results faxed to this office.

Blue Hole Management, Inc. will receive a general compliance letter. Blue Hole Management has made some recordkeeping and sampling improvements since the previous investigation. However, specific areas of concern will be included with the general compliance letter in regards to the annual soil samples and reporting being appropriately submitted, inclusion of the emergency generator on the permit without an emergency generator being present, and resampling due to the inconclusive result on the December sample for BOD.



This letter is in reference to the BOD result for sample Al18729. This sample was setup in a three dilution series. Each dilution had a higher final dissolved oxygen reading than the initial dissolved oxygen reading. As the amount of sample in the increased, so did the final dissolved oxygen reading. This is the opposite of what seen on typical BOD/CBOD samples. This phenomenon is only observed when something in the sample is releasing oxygen, such as hydrogen peroxide or poss.

Please evaluate your process to see if a chemical such as the ones mentioned accould have been in the sample. It was also noted that the sample was very non chlorine.

# INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GUADALUPE-BLANCO RIVER AUTHORITY AND THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY

STATE OF TEXAS

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COUNTY OF HAYS

This Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of the day of April, 2002 (the "Effective Date") by and between the GUADALUPE-BLANCO RIVER AUTHORITY ("GBRA") a conservation and reclamation district and political subdivision of the State of Texas created pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59 of the Texas Constitution by special act of the Legislature formerly compiled at Article 8280-106, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes and the VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, Texas ("WIMBERLEY"), each organized and existing under Texas law and acting in a lawful manner through their authorized representatives.

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, WIMBERLEY and the GBRA desire to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement in accordance with the terms and provisions of Chapter 791, Texas Govt. Code ("Interlocal Cooperation Act"); and

WHEREAS, Texas law allows governmental entities to enter into interlocal agreements to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of local governments by authorizing them to contract with one another; and

WHEREAS, WIMBERLEY has applied for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide retail sewer service for the residents and businesses within the requested area covered by the CCN; and

WHEREAS, WIMBERLEY desires to have the GBRA develop, design, finance, construct, permit, operate and maintain sewer facilities on behalf of WIMBERLEY; and

WHEREAS, WIMBERLEY has determined that contracting with the GBRA to operate and maintain sewer facilities on behalf of WIMBERLEY will increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the retail sewer service provided to its residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the GBRA has reviewed the needs of WIMBERLEY and determined that it can efficiently and effectively develop, design, finance, construct, permit, operate and maintain sewer facilities in the service area of WIMBERLEY's CCN; and

WHEREAS, WIMBERLEY and the GBRA have heretofore entered into that certain agreement dated April 2, 2002 (the "Operating Agreement") wherein GBRA has agreed to develop, design, finance, permit, construct, operate and maintain a sewer

system to provide retail sewer service to residents and businesses located with WIMBERLEY's CCN service area.

WHEREAS, WIMBERLEY's City Council has reviewed and voted to accept the terms of this Agreement by a duly constituted quorum of the City Council at a properly noticed and called meeting of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the GBRA has reviewed and voted to accept the terms of this Agreement by a duly constituted quorum of the GBRA Board at a properly noticed and called meeting of the GBRA Board.

# <u>AGREEMENT</u>

Now, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

# 1. <u>Definitions</u>

"WIMBERLEY". The term WIMBERLEY refers to Village of Wimberley, the City Council of the Village of Wimberley and any and all officers and/or employees of the Village of Wimberley.

"CCN" or "Certificate of Convenience and Necessity". The terms CCN and Certificate of Convenience and Necessity refer to the CCN permit requested and to be issued by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission to WIMBERLEY for the provision of retail sewer service to the Customers within the territorial boundaries of the CCN.

"Customer". The term Customer generally refers to any residential or business user of retail sewer service within the service area of WIMBERLEY's CCN.

"Services". The term Services refers to the retail sewer service provided by the GBRA to WIMBERLEY in accordance with the Operating Agreement.

# 2. <u>Commitments of the GBRA</u>

- (a) In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, and upon approval of the Operating Agreement by GBRA and WIMBERLEY, GBRA will, in accordance with the terms and conditions of said agreement, develop, design, finance, permit and construct any and all capital improvements necessary to own, operate and maintain sewer facilities for WIMBERLEY and to provide retail sewer service to Customers within the service area of WIMBERLEY's CCN.
- (b) GBRA agrees to support WIMBERLEY's Application for a CCN with technical and legal support services; provided, however, GBRA shall have

the right to provide input to WIMBERLEY on all material issues relating to WIMBERLEY's Application for a CCN and should WIMBERLEY and GBRA fail to reach agreement on any such material issue, GBRA shall have the sole and exclusive right and discretion to withdraw its legal and technical support services of WIMBERLEY's Application for a CCN.

# 3. <u>Commitments of WIMBERLEY</u>

In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Operating Agreement, WIMBERLEY hereby agrees to provide GBRA with the exclusive right to service any and all Customers within the service area of WIMBERLEY's CCN for the provision of Services for so long as this Agreement and the Operating Agreement are in effect.

# 4. Compensation

Compensation paid by WIMBERLEY and Customers to GBRA for the development, design, financing, permitting, construction, operation and maintenance of the sewer facilities shall be in accordance with the Operating Agreement.

# 5. Term of the Agreement

The term of this Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and continue in effect for so long as the Operating Agreement remains in effect.

# 6. <u>Termination of the Agreement</u>

Neither Party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement for so long as the Operating Agreement remains in effect. This Agreement shall terminate upon the termination of the Operating Agreement.

# 7. <u>Indemnification</u>

ONLY TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY TEXAS LAW, EACH PARTY SHALL INDEMNIFY, DEFEND, AND HOLD HARMLESS THE OTHER PARTY, ITS OFFICIALS, OFFICERS, TRUSTEES, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES, BOTH PRESENT AND FUTURE, FROM ANY CLAIMS, EXPENSES, COSTS (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ALL COSTS OF DEFENSE, SUCH AS FEES AND CHARGES OF ATTORNEYS, EXPERT WITNESSES AND OTHER PROFESSIONALS AND ALL COURT OR ARBITRATION OR OTHER DISPUTE RESOLUTION COSTS), DEMANDS, JUDGMENTS, CAUSES OF ACTION, SUITS OR LIABILITY OF ANY NATURE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, CLAIMS FOR BODILY INJURY, DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE WHICH MAY ARISE FROM THE NEGLIGENT OPERATION OF THE SEWER FACILITIES. THIS

# INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATION SHALL SURVIVE THE TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT.

# 8. No Liability for Torts

Each Party to this Agreement agrees that it shall have no liability for the actions or omissions of the employees, agents, or trustees of the other Party, and each Party is solely responsible for the actions and omissions of its own employees, trustees, or agents. Each Party specifically waives any claim, obligation, or cause of action for the tortious conduct of the other Party.

# 9. Amendments to Agreement

This Agreement can only be amended in writing by mutual agreement of the Parties.

# 10. Severability

All provisions to this Agreement are declared to be severable, in the event that any one section or provision is held to be illegal or unconstitutional.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned Village of Wimberley, Texas and the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority hereto, through their authorized representatives, execute this Interlocal Agreement in duplicate.



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# OPERATING AGREEMENT BETWEEN VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS AND GUADALUPE-BLANCO RIVER AUTHORITY

This Operating Agreement Between Village of Wimberley, Texas and Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (this "Operating Agreement") is made and entered into as of the and approach and 2002, (the "Effective Date") by and between the Village of Wimberley, Texas ("Wimberley"), and the GUADALUPE-BLANCO RIVER AUTHORITY ("GBRA"), a conservation and reclamation district and political subdivision of the State of Texas created pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59 of the Texas Constitution by special act of the Legislature, formerly compiled at Article 8280-106, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes.

## RECITALS

Wimberley has applied for a Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity which will authorize Wimberley to provide retail sewer service within the territory shown by the map attached as Exhibit 1 (the "Wimberley Service Area").

This Operating Agreement provides for the development, permitting, design, construction operation and maintenance of a Wastewater Project by GBRA for Wimberley for retail sewer service to Users within the Wimberley Service Area.

# **AGREEMENT**

For and in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, obligations, and benefits described in this Operating Agreement, and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, GBRA and Wimberley agree as follows:

### ARTICLE I

## **DEFINITIONS**

"Annual Debt Service Requirement" means the total principal and interest scheduled to come due on all Bonds during each twelve month period ending on August 31 of each year, plus a debt service coverage factor as determined by GBRA and provided by the Bond Resolution but not to exceed 10% of such principal and interest unless GBRA and Wimberley mutually agree upon a greater percentage, less interest to be paid out of Bond proceeds as permitted by the applicable Bond Resolution, if any.

"Annual Operation and Maintenance Requirement" for a project means the total amount budgeted by GBRA for each twelve month period ending on August 31 of each year to pay all estimated Operation and Maintenance Expenses for that project.
