Your application has been received by the Utilities & Districts Section to begin the technical review. The technical review and the administrative review will be conducted concurrently in an effort to be more efficient in our review of your application. Ms. Lisa Mejia has been assigned to perform the technical review. The application has been assigned Application No. 34656-C. Please refer to this number in future correspondence.

Your next step is to provide the **revised** public notices without delay. The notice to the public must be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Travis County. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide correct notice of the application to any utilities within two (2) miles of your proposed service area, any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area or other affected parties in your requested area. Check the notices carefully before mailing or publishing.

As proof that notice was provided, you are required to send us the following:

- a) an original and three copies of a publisher's affidavit of the newspaper publication with tear sheets of the published notice attached;
- b) four copies of each individual notice and map sent to neighboring utilities and other affected parties; and
- c) an original and three copies of the signed affidavits that individual notice to neighboring utilities and affected individuals has been given. (Copies of the Affidavit forms are enclosed with this letter.)

Include the enclosed location map delineating the proposed service area to be decertified with your individual notices to neighboring utilities and other affected parties.

Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
