



CITY OF AUSTIN'S OBJECTIONS TO PROPOSED LISTS OF APPLICABLE STATUTES AND RULES

On August 1, 2002, the parties filed lists of applicable statutes and rules. The City of Austin ("City") objects to the designation of certain proposed provisions as being applicable and relevant to this proceeding as follows:

STATUTES:

1. Texas Water Code Chapter 5

The City objects to the entire chapter being designated as suggested by the Aligned Parties because not all sections are relevant to this proceeding, but has no objections to the sections suggested by the Lower Colorado River Authority ("LCRA").

2. Texas Water Code Chapter 13

The City objects to the Aligned Parties' designation of the entire chapter because not all sections are relevant to this proceeding, but has no objection to LCRA's list of applicable sections, except Section 13.241. In section 13.241, part (d) is not applicable because facilities constructed by the City will be part of the City's centralized, regional system.

The City has no objection to provisions suggested by Hornsby Bend Utility Company ("Hornsby") and the Executive Director ("ED"), except to the extent that the entire

subchapter G is designated; the City reiterates its qualified agreement to LCRA's designations in subchapter G (see above).

3. Texas Water Code Chapter 26

The City objects to the Aligned Parties' designation of Chapter 26. Chapter 26 is not relevant to the determination of whether an entity should be granted a certificate of convenience and necessity.

4. Texas Health & Safety Code Chapter 341

The City objects to the Aligned Parties' designation of Chapter 341 except for Sections 341.001(3) and 341.031(a), which provide the drinking water standards mentioned in 30 TAC § 291.102(a)(1).

RULES AND POLICIES

The City objects to the inclusion of part (b) of 30 TAC section 291.102 and <u>The Feasibility of Regionalization</u>, August 3, 1999 document because facilities constructed by the City will be part of the City's centralized, regional system; therefore, this rule and policy are not applicable.

Consequently, the City requests that the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") find that the statutes, rules, and policies to which the City objects are not relevant to this proceeding and that the ALJ not include them in the ALJ's order concerning applicable statutes, rules, and policies.
