## Dear Judge Sullivan:

The purpose of this letter is to request clarification regarding the date on which discovery in this proceeding is supposed to begin.

The City of Austin submitted a draft scheduling order to you, per your instructions in Order No. 3, on July 29, 2002. The draft scheduling order provided that discovery would begin on August 1, 2002. Although the parties were not in agreement concerning certain scheduling issues, it is our understanding that none of the parties objected to discovery beginning on August 1, 2002.

Although the start date does not appear to be in dispute, we are hesitant to begin sending discovery requests without confirmation that the August 1 date is approved by you. On the other hand, we are concerned that by not acting, we may be inadvertently losing valuable discovery time, if in fact you intended August 1 to be the start date.

Accordingly, we request that you clarify the date upon which discovery is scheduled to begin. If we do not receive a response from you by 3:30 p.m. tomorrow, August 8, 2002, we will assume that discovery has already begun. Thank you for your consideration of this matter.
