TO THE HONORABLE KERRY SULLIVAN, ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:**


Pursuant to the presiding judge's directive at the prehearing conference of September 3, 2002, all remaining parties to these consolidated dockets have conferred by email, in person or by telephone with the undersigned counsel for the Aligned Parties concerning a revision to the hearing and discovery schedule in Order No. 2 to accommodate depositions after the pre-filing of testimony. All parties agreed to the following language, which has been taken verbatim from an email circulated by the undersigned to all counsel of record and Mr. Gary Bradley on September 5, 2002. No response was requested from Mr. Bradley because he had previously informed the undersigned that he had mailed his withdrawal notice to SOAH.

1. All dates in Order No. 2 remain unchanged.
2. Depositions of witnesses for all parties' cases in chief end on May 9, 2003
3. Applicants prefiled rebuttal testimony on May 16, 2003
4. Depositions on rebuttal witnesses limited to rebuttal testimony end on May 22, 2002

To make this schedule work, Applicants will be on notice that their rebuttal witnesses will be subject to having their depositions taken in Austin with not less than 24 hours but not more than 48 hours notice unless otherwise agreed to by counsel. Notice can be given by fax to counsel.

By agreement of counsel for the remaining parties communicated through the undersigned, it is requested that Order No. 2 be supplemented to accommodate the dates and notice provisions set forth above.


