Dear Mr. Baromeo:

Your application was received on October 15, 1999. It has been accepted for filing. The application has been assigned Application No. 32800-C. Please refer to this number in future correspondence.

Your next step is to provide the public notices without delay. The notice to the public must be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Travis County. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide notice of the application to any utilities within two (2) miles of your proposed service area, any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area, customers, or other affected parties in your requested area.

There is a pending application (A-230-8) from AquaSource Development Company requesting a proposed service area within two miles of your proposed service area. I recommend that you also provide notice to AquaSource Development Company.

As proof that notice was provided, you are required to send us the following:

- a) an original and three copies of a publisher's affidavit of the newspaper publication with tear sheets of the published notice attached;
- b) four copies of each individual notice to neighboring utilities and other affected parties;
- c) an original and three copies of the signed affidavits that individual notice to neighboring utilities and affected individuals has been given. (Copies of the Affidavit forms are attached to this letter.)

These items must be completed and returned by December 31, 1999. Processing of this application cannot proceed until the close of the 30 day public comment period which begins after all the required notices have been given.

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

If one or more requests for a bearing are filed, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office Administrative Hearings (SOAH) where a hearing may be held. In the event an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If a hearing is held it will be a legal proceeding similar to civil trials in State District Court.
