In conducting further review of the issues associated with the SAWS Motion to Intervene, this morning I discovered ALJ Leslie Craven's Proposal for Decision ("PFD") rendered in SOAH Docket No. 582-00-0546, which related to an application by Creedmoor-Maha WSC to amend its water service CCN. 

In the PFD, Judge Craven analyzed the City of Austin's argument that its late-filed competing CCN application should work to stay the already-pending proceeding relating to Creedmoor-Maha's application. Not only did Judge Craven reject this argument, but she also disposed of the City's contention that it maintained special "standing" because it might "someday" be required to serve the proposed area, which lied within its ETJ.

Because the issues raised and determined by Judge Craven in that proceeding largely mirror the arguments proffered by SAWS herein, BexarMet respectfully requests that you review that PFD during your consideration of the SAWS Motion to Intervene.
