APPLICANT, BEXAR METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT'S, RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO BITTERBLUE, INC.'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW, Bexar Metropolitan Water District ("BexarMet"), Applicant in the above-numbered and styled administrative proceeding, and files this, its Response in Opposition to the Motion to Intervene¹ filed by Bitterblue, Inc. ("Bitterblue"). In support of this Opposition, BexarMet shows as follows:

1. <u>Bitterblue Lacks the Requisite Standing and Justiciable Interest</u> <u>Required for Intervention/Party Status</u>

Bitterblue has not alleged, and cannot demonstrate that it is a city or a neighboring water system. Moreover, Bitterblue has not alleged, and cannot prove that it is a landowner, owning property in BexarMet's proposed service area.² Indeed, Bitterblue is not even an "affected person,"

now or at the time that the application to amend was filed.³ Bitterblue's best argument proffered in support of its claimed justiciable interest is that it is the "General Partner" of various limited partnerships, which purportedly own property within the proposed area. However, as more fully described herein, this assertion is simply untrue. As a result, Bitterblue wholly lacks standing to intervene in this case, and has absolutely no direct, demonstrable interest in the outcome of this proceeding. Stated differently, Bitterblue lacks the justiciable interest required by 30 TAC § 80.109(a) for intervention and party status.

A. <u>Biteblue Does Not Own Real Property Within the Proposed Service Area.</u>

Bitterblue's Motion to Intervene affirmatively states that it "owns" or has "a contract to acquire an ownership interest in" property within the proposed area. However, review of the official property records and tax rolls maintained by the Bexar Appraisal District belies this assertion, and reveals that Bitterblue owns only two (2) parcels of real property in Bexar County, Texas: (i) a tract of land situated at 6210 De Zevala Road; and (ii) a tract located on Boeme Stage Road. See Exhibit A, attached hereto.

It is undisputed that *neither* of Bitterblue's properties are situated within the area made the subject of this proceeding. As such, Bitterblue is not a "landowner" with respect to BexarMet's application, and its allegations concerning "ownership" are false.

B. <u>Bitterblue is "Not" the General Partner of Any Owner of Any Tract in the Proposed Area</u>

Similarly, in the very first sentence of Paragraph I of its Motion to Intervene, Bitterblue alleges that it "is the General Partner of the Limited Partnerships" which do own the property in question.⁵ This identical claim is made in the Affidavit of William Eugene Powell attached as "Exhibit C" to Bitterblue's Motion.. However, such an assertion is also patently false.

In stark contrast to both Bitterblue's Motion to Intervene, and Mr. Powell's sworn Affidavit testimony, the official corporation records of the Texas Secretary of State reveal the following:

- i. The "Longover Partnership" is not a partnership, corporation or other agency registered with the Texas of State, and there exists no registered limited partnership operating under the name "Longover Partnership." See Exhibit B.
- ii. The General Partner of "Bass Properties, L.P." is Bass Properties, Management, L.L.C. See Exhibit C.
- iii. The general partner of The Kinder Partnership, Ltd., 8 is "Kinder Management, Inc." See Exhibit D.

Indeed, <u>Bitterblue is not the General partner of any limited partnership which owns</u> property within the proposed area. This fact is admitted in Bitterblue's "Supplement" to its Motion to Intervene, which is completely inconsistent with the original Motion to Intervene, and with Mr. Powell's affidavit. Based upon the demonstrable untruths in the affidavit, which was made under

oath, there exist serious doubts about the Affiant's overall credibility.

A party has a justiciable interest in a proceeding only when his interests will be affected by the litigation. Only the landowning limited partnerships (if they exist at all) maintain a justiciable interest in those proceedings. In order to properly assert that justiciable interest, those landowners would be required to seek party status by and through their general partners. Bitterblue, however, is neither a landowner, nor a General Partner of any partnership owning land in the proposed area. As such, Bitterblue's Motion to Intervene fails on grounds of lack of standing and lack of justiciable interest. On the proposed interest.

II. <u>Bitterblue is More Than Three Years Late</u> <u>in Opposing BexarMet's Application / Seeking Party Status and Inclusion Now Would</u> <u>Unreasonably Delay This Proceeding</u>

Both Bitterblue and the landowners it purports to represent failed to file protests or requests for contested case hearings within the 30 day protest period prescribed by 30 TAC § 291.106 (a)(3). But for the timely protest of BSR, BexarMet's instant application could have been granted by the Executive Director of the TNRCC as long ago as May 2002. Had such action occurred, Bitterblue would have no procedural vehicle within which to make the contrived allegations of 13th hour "justiciable interest" and "extenuating circumstances" it now advances in its Motion to Intervene.

Bitterblue (and the alleged "Limited Partnerships" owning the subject property) not only

missed the deadline for the protest period prescribed by the agency and its internal rules, but it also disregarded the opportunity to petition the ALJ for party status in July 2003 (at the time of the preliminary hearing). Like SAWS, Bitterblue has made no effort to intervene in this case during the two years since. Allowing Bitterblue to intervene at this late date would cast aside the substantial efforts and expenditures of both BexarMet and BSR, which have each met all of the deadlines prescribed by Order No. 9. BexarMet, in addition to disrupting the work activities of its employee-witnesses, has engaged the services of expert witnesses, court reporters, copy services, and couriers in order to meet the deadlines established by Order No. 9. Obviously, there were substantial expenditures associated with this compliance. These costs cannot be recovered through this proceeding, and extension of the duration of this proceeding will certainly result in redundant expenditures and escalating attorneys' fees and costs.

This proceeding is set for Hearing on the Merits on October 17, 2005, and the deadline for completion of discovery has already passed.¹³ Introducing Bitterblue as an Intervenor to this case will undoubtedly cause the instant "hearing in progress [to] be unreasonably delayed."¹⁴ This fact, alone, justifies denial of the Motion to Intervene.

III. <u>There Exist No "Extenuating Circumstances"</u> <u>Requiring Bitterblue's Participation in This Proceeding</u>

Like those concocted by SAWS, Bitterblue's purported "extenuating circumstances" are largely contrived. Bitterblue's Motion fails to reference or identify "extenuating circumstances,"

and the attached Affidavit reveals little more than a case of "sour grapes." Bitterblue is a developer corporation, whose principals have a history of disagreements with BexarMet. Most of Mr. Powell's affidavit testimony is a rambling recitation of that history, which is wholly irrelevant – especially since most of the "facts" alleged in the Affidavit relate to BexarMet's dealings with Denton Development Company, Inc. 15 – a corporation who has nothing to do with this proceeding, and has not sought party status herein. Indeed, the timing of Bitterblue's Intervention, alone, is suspect as it correlates closely with BexarMet's demand that Denton Development pays to BexarMet substantial sums which are due and owing. *See Exhibit E.* The true purpose of Bitterblue's Motion is simply leverage and retaliation, and has little to do with Bitterblue's concern about the merits of BexarMet's application.

Taking another page out of the SAWS play book, Bitterblue asks the ALJ to accept as true Mr. Powell's false, conclusory, and unqualified allegations concerning matters such as SAWS' and BexarMet's respective capabilities, and the utilities' respective rates. Not only are these "conclusions" unfounded and made by a person with insufficient testimonial qualifications, but they are clearly objectionable, and should not be considered under any stretch of evidentiary decorum, especially in light of the proven falsehoods concerning Bitterblue's status as "General Partner." BexarMet also objects to the form of the Affidavit insofar as the document purports to state "facts" *prior to* the certification by the Affiant that all such "facts" are "true and correct" and

Paragraph II of the Motion to Intervene makes several references to representations and demands made by BexarMet with respect to Bitterblue. BexarMet would show that Bitterblue was not a party to the "Oliver Ranch" Development, and that BexarMet issued a demand to Denton Development, and not Bitterblue. Bexause denton failed to respond to BexarMet's justified demands, BexarMet was required to file a collections lawsuit against denton. Bitterblue is not a party to that action.

made "upon personal knowledge."

IV. Conclusion

Bitterblue's untimely Motion to Intervene must be denied on grounds that Bitterblue lacks a justiciable interest in this proceeding. Moreover, Bitterblue has failed to meet its sole burden of demonstrating good cause and extenuating circumstances justifying its late-entry into this proceeding. Finally, the Motion fails to rebut the fact that the delay occasioned by granting Bitterblue party status can only be unreasonable, given the advanced stages of this proceeding, and the substantial resources expended by Applicant and the other existing parties.

<u>PRAYER</u>

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, BexarMet prays that the ALJ denies the Motion of Bitterblue, Inc. to Intervene. BexarMet further prays for all relief to which it may be entitled at law or in equity.





PLAINTIFF'S ORIGINAL PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

BEXAR METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT ("BexarMet") Plaintiff herein, files its Original Petition against DENTON DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, INC., ("Denton") and would show unto this Court the following:

Discovery Level. Discovery in this case is intended to be conducted under Level 2 of Rule 190 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure

Parties. Plaintiff is a water conservation district and a body politic and corporate, created and operating pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59 of the Constitution of the State of Texas and Texas Revised Civil Statutes Articles 8280-126, as amended, and a political subdivision of the State of Texas, with its principal place of business located at 2047 W. Malone, P.O. Box 245994, San Antonio, Texas 78224-5994. Defendant is a corporation organized and existing under Texas law, with a place of business in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas and can be served by serving its registered agent for service Ann D. Wells at 1919 Oakwell Farms Pky, Suite #125A, San Antonio, Texas 78218.

Venue. Venue in Bexar County is proper in this cause under Section 15.002 (a) (1) of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code because all or a substantial part of the events or omissions giving rise to this lawsuit occurred in this county.

CAUSES OF ACTION

Collection of Impact Fees.

BexarMet is a political subdivision of the State of Texas and is governed by V.T.C.A., Water Code Section 49.001 et.seq. Pursuant to Section 49.212 (d) of the Water Code, BexarMet has the authority to charge an impact fee for, "construction, installation, or inspection of a tap or connection to district water, sanitary sewer, or drainage facilities, including all necessary service lines and meters, or for wholesale facilities that serve such water, sanitary sewer, or drainage facilities . . . " Section 49.212 (a) provides the following:

> A district may adopt and enforce all necessary charges, mandatory fees, or rentals in addition to taxes, for providing or making available any district facility or service, including fire-fighting activities provided under Section 49.351.

Denton is a developer who requested that BexarMet supply water connections to its Oliver Ranch (a/k/a Lookout Canyon) development. On or about May 2000, BexarMet commenced construction of the infrastructure to provide the Oliver Ranch development with water. The construction was complete on or about January 2001. In the Oliver Ranch development in question, there exists Two Thousand Nine Hundred Forty (2,940) Equivalent Dwelling Units ("EDUs") for which Denton is obligated to pay impact fees to BexarMet in the amount of \$494.50 per edu. The total sum of impact fees due to BexarMet is \$1,453,830.00. Denton has paid BexarMet a total of \$819,861.00 of this amount. Denton owes the balance of \$633,969.00 which is currently due to BexarMet. As authorized by statute, BexarMet brings this cause of action to enforce and collect the balance due on impact fees owed by Denton.

B. Alternative Pleading Breach of Contract

Pleading in the alternative and not waiving the above-referenced cause of action, On or about March 27, 2001, BexarMet and Denton entered into a contract whereby Denton agreed to grant BexarMet certain water utility and service easements, Denton agreed to pay a portion of construction costs of certain water facilities to extend water service lines and facilities to the Oliver Ranch (a/k/a Lookout Canyon) development and to dedicate to BexarMet a 1.92 parcel of land for construction of a water storage tank and a 0.18 parcel of land for a proposed water well. Denton has not conveyed the above-referenced parcels to BexarMet and is therefore in breach of the contract. BexarMet seeks specific performance for Denton to convey the above-referenced parcels to BexarMet.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays that Defendant be cited to appear and answer and that upon final trial of this cause, Plaintiff recovers:

- Judgment against Defendant for unpaid impact fees in the amount of \$633,969.00;
- Prejudgment interest on Plaintiff's damages as allowed by law;
- Interest on the judgment at the legal rate from date of judgment;
- 4. In the alternative, specific performance under the contract for Denton to convey to BexarMet the two parcels of land;
- 5. Costs of court; and

6. Such other and further relief to which Plaintiff may be entitled.
