Dear Ms. Church:

Pursuant to your Order of Abatement in this case, Bitterblue is filing this additional status report. Attached is a copy of the letter from Judge Steel in the pending Comal County case involving Bexar Met and GBRA. Judge Steel's letter indicates that he has granted GBRA's motion for summary judgment in that case holding that Bexar Met has no authority to provide retail water service outside its boundaries. It is our understanding that it is primarily on this basis of this pending litigation involving a threshold issue in the CCN case that you abated the Bexar Met CCN case before you. Because Judge Steel's holding was the basis of Bitterblue's Motion for Summary Disposition in the referenced docket pending before you, Bitterblue respectfully requests that its motion for summary disposition be granted and that Bexar Met's application be dismissed as to any areas outside of its boundaries. This would include all of the areas which Bitterblue owns or controls as stated in its petition for intervention which you earlier granted.
