I. SETTING HEARING ON THE MERITS

The hearing on the merits of this is set to begin at 9:00 a.m. on October 30, 2006, at the William P. Clements Office Building, 300 West 15th, Fourth Floor, Austin Texas. It shall continue from day to day. A total of five days has been set aside for this hearing and the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) anticipates concluding the hearing by close of business on November 3, 2006.¹

III. PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

The pre-hearing conference will convene at 2:00 p.m. on October 23, 2006, by telephone. Matters to considered include the necessity for time limits for case presentations, any pending motions, special scheduling issues, or other hearing-organization matters to aid in efficient presentation of the case.

IV. HEARING PROCEDURES

The general hearing procedures regarding discovery matters, pagination of exhibits, provision for a court reporter, and the like, were set out in full in Order No. 9. These procedures are hereby *reaffirmed* and apply to further proceedings in this case, as if set forth fully in this order.

V. ORDER OF HEARING

The following amended order of hearing is adopted. Unless otherwise ordered, the parties will present their cases and cross-examine other parties' witnesses in the following order:

Order of Direct Cases:

Order of Cross Examination:

Applicant's witnesses will be cross-examined by BSR, Bitterblue, ED, and OPIC. BSR's witnesses will be cross-examined by BSR, Bitterblue, ED, Applicant, and OPIC.




