RULE 11 AGREEMENT TO EXTEND TIME TO TAKE DEPOSITIONS AND MOTIONS TO COMPEL

A. Introduction

The City of Austin ("City") and the Lower Colorado River Authority ("LCRA") file this agreement, made pursuant to Texas Rules of Civil Procedure 11 and 191.1, and 1 TAC § 155.31, to extend time to notice and take depositions and to file motions to compel between the City and LCRA (the "Agreement").

1. Discovery in this suit is governed by scheduling order, as set forth by the Administrative Law Judge (the "Scheduling Order"). The discovery period in this matter began on August 1, 2002 and will end on February 10, 2003 (the "Discovery Period").

2. The case is set for hearing June 2, 2003 through June 20, 2003.

B. Agreement

- 1. Pursuant to the Scheduling Order, the City and LCRA are entitled to take depositions at any time during the Discovery Period. No depositions have been taken between these parties as of the date of this Agreement.
- 2. Pursuant to the Scheduling Order, motions to compel may be filed within five working days of receipt of objections.
- 3. The City and LCRA agree to extend the time for taking depositions until February 28, 2003 and extend the time for filing motions to compel until January 10, 2003.
- 4. The City agrees to extend the time for LCRA to respond to the City's Second Set of Interrogatories, Requests for Production and Admissions to December 17, 2002.
- 5. The signatures below evidence the City's and LCRA's intent that this shall serve as a Rule 11 agreement, enforceable upon filing with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
