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This is in response to your phone call and fax. I have spoke with Kent Steelman about your concerns and it appears the only difference in the two maps is that a portion of Windermere Utility Co., CCN 11471 was removed. The Manville WSC (11144) area is the same on both. You can see the number "11144" with a large solid dot pointing to their area on both maps. The solid dot indicates facilities + 200 feet. At one time, Windermere had dual certification with Manville. City of Austin transferred and canceled that portion of Windermere Utility Co. (possibly App. No. 30773-C), which left Manville's facilities + 200 feet singly certificated. This allows Manville WSC to legally serve 1/4 mile outside of their CCN. However, any connections outside of the CCN are not protected until the CCN is amended to include the additional area.

Unfortunately this problem has brought to our attention that City of Austin's pending CCN application has an additional overlap that was not identified earlier. For Austin to certificate that area where Manville has facilities + 200 feet, we will need an agreement for dual certification from Manville WSC or we can "carve out" the facilities + 200 feet from Austin's CCN. Also, if you can fax me more information locating that address on West Pecan, I will try to identify if it is in a CCN or not.
